





THANK YOU to all who attended our Culture of Life Ministry's presentation on Assisted Suicide on May 1st. Thank you to Peter Wolfgang, Executive Director of The Family Institute of Connecticut, for a very informative discussion. The question, "Is assisted suicide coming for Connecticut?" was the topic of the evening, and the answer is "Not this year". However, Mr. Wolfgang explained that the issue will certainly be pushed again next year. He discussed the history of the assisted suicide fight in CT, and he described the diverse group of allies who have joined together in the fight. He explained that some of the strongest opponents of assisted suicide are people with disabilities. Mr. Wolfgang, an attorney with decades of experience on this issue, also explained that in states where assisted suicide was legalized several years ago "with safeguards" in place to protect vulnerable people from abuse, those protections are not being called "barriers" and the 'slippery slope' has indeed led to abuse.



HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

- 1. Begin by making the Sign of the Cross.
- 2. Holding the crucifix pray the **Apostles' Creed**.
- 3. On the first bead pray the Our Father.
- 4. Pray one **Hail Mary** on the next three beads for an increase in faith, hope and charity.
- 5. On the next bead pray the Glory Be.
- Before praying the next set of ten beads (called a 'decade'), state the first mystery, imagine the event, and meditate on it. Then pray 1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's and the Glory Be. Fatima Prayer is optional.
- 7. Repeat until the five decades are prayed.
- 8. Pray the Hail, Holy Queen.
- 9. Finish by making the Sign of the Cross




