

### **PASTOR'S COLUMN**

**First Communicants** - Congratulations to the 90 students in this year's 1<sup>st</sup> Communion Class! Their names were on the cover of last week's bulletin and there are some pictures from the two Masses on page 5. We pray that their love of Jesus in the Eucharist will grow with each time they receive Him, which we pray will be weekly. Join me in thanking all of those who helped them prepare for this very special moment including our 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teacher in the school, Lisa Jensen, as well as our 3<sup>rd</sup> grade catechists in our Religious Education Program: Suzanne Ciarcia, John Healey, Karen Lyons and Chris Pelosi.

Another successful year of Religious Education has come to a conclusion. With the Confirmations and First Communion celebrations completed and the end of classes, I am once again so very grateful to our Director of Religious Education, Mrs. Robin Veronesi, who does such an exemplary job in leading our entire Religious Education program with over 550 students and dozens of catechists who make up the program along with other volunteers. She is always looking to improve the program and is very diligent and patient in coordinating the program. Robin has the benefit of being assisted by Christina Norton and our dedicated catechists and volunteers. May the Lord bless all of them for helping share the gift of faith with our youth!!

**Children's Masses Continue -** This past November we were able to reinstitute the Children's Masses. Keeping in mind that we have an obligation to attend Mass weekly, the Children's Masses will continue during the summer. I am heartened that parishioners appreciate the importance of these opportunities to focus the liturgy for our youngest parishioners and their families. How blessed we are to have young families and children in our worshiping community. See page 10 for the upcoming schedule of Children's Masses.

**Feast of** *Corpus Christi* (Body of Christ) - Sunday, June 11 is the Feast of *Corpus Christi* this year. This is a doctrinal feast and in it we proclaim our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. While this feast is essential to who we are as Catholics, the feast is not so much about proclaiming a doctrine as it is proclaiming how our God wants to relate to us and be close to us. God can be no closer to us than when we receive Holy Communion since we are receiving Jesus himself. Unfortunately, according to recent surveys, many Catholics have lost belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The Bishops of the United States have implemented a three year program to help teach this fundamental belief once again.

Beginning with the Feast of *Corpus Christi* and culminating with a Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July, 2024, the parish level of this revitalization in the belief in the Real Presence of Jesus is being undertaken. Those of us who have a few more years under our belts will recall Eucharistic

processions either as part of 40 Hours Devotions or on the Feast of *Corpus Christi*. Throughout the Archdiocese of Hartford, all parishes are being asked to have a Eucharistic procession this year for the Feast of *Corpus Christi*. We will have our procession following the 4:00 pm Mass on June 10. The procession will begin at the end of Mass and proceed to the gazebo on the Parish Green. I hope as many as possible will be part of the procession. More details will be shared in the coming weeks.

Ministry Fair Weekend June 3 & 4 - There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. (1 Cor. 12: 5-7) Our annual Ministry Fair will be held the weekend of June 3 & 4 in the school gym following all Masses. All parish organizations and ministries will have information available and members present to invite parishioners to share the gifts of the Holy Spirit given to them by God with the parish and the wider community. In addition to this being an opportunity to learn how you can share your gifts, it is also an opportunity to find out what parish programs and ministries can be of help to you and your family. On Saturday evening (June 3) the Pastoral Council will provide complimentary pizza and beverages and on Sunday (June 4) the Knights of Columbus will provide a free hot breakfast. Free will donations will be accepted to help the cover the cost of the food. So save the date and plan on attending.


