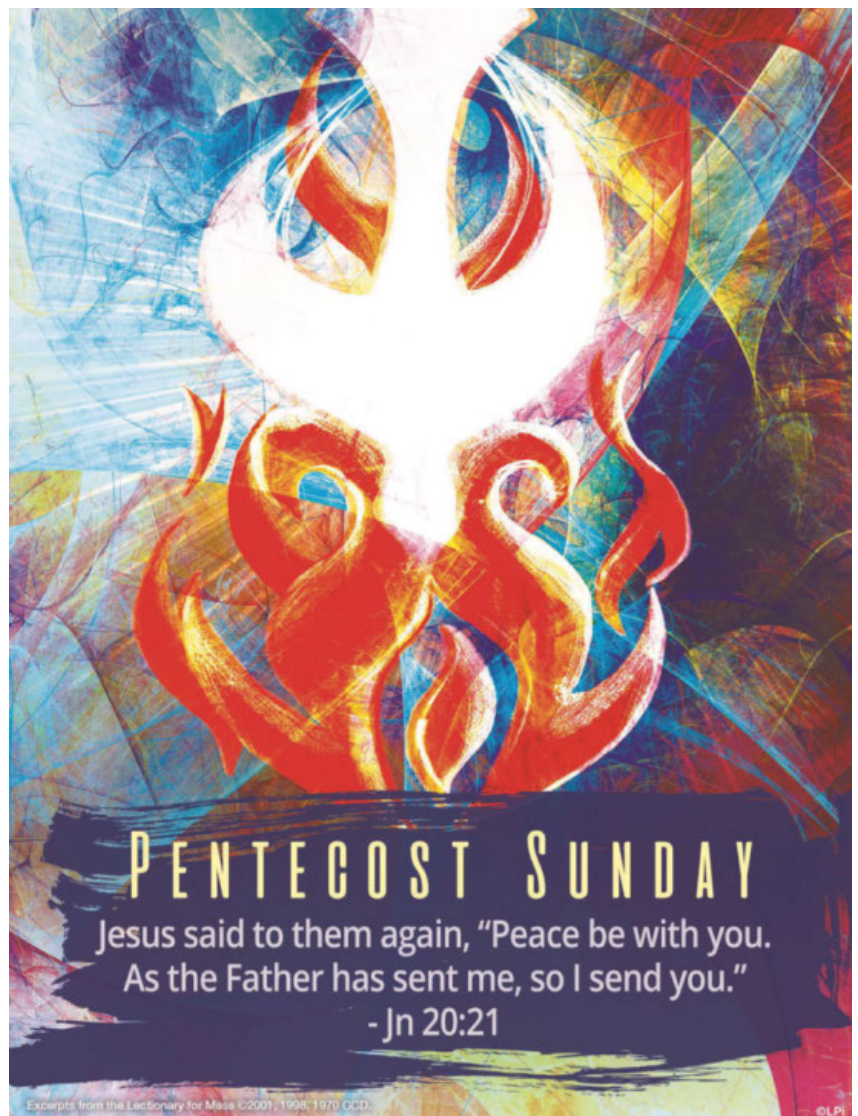

**Pentecost** - Today we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. This is the third most important celebration of the year after Easter and Christmas. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* says "The moral life of Christians is sustained by the gifts of the Holy Spirit. These are permanent dispositions which make [us] docile in following the promptings of the Holy Spirit. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord." St. Bonaventure composed the following prayer about the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

We beg the all-merciful Father through thee, his only-begotten Son made man for our sake, crucified and glorified for us, to send upon us from his treasure-house the Spirit of sevenfold grace, who rested upon thee in all his fullness:

- \* the spirit of *wisdom*, enabling us to relish the fruit of the tree of life, which is indeed thyself;
- \* the gift of *understanding*: to enlighten our perceptions;
- \* the gift of *prudence*, enabling us to follow in thy footsteps;
- \* the gift of *strength*: to withstand our adversary's onslaught;
- \* the gift of *knowledge*: to distinguish good from evil by the light of thy holy teaching;
- \* the gift of *piety*: to clothe ourselves with charity and mercy;
- \* the gift of *fear*: to withdraw from all ill-doing and live quietly in awe of thy eternal majesty.

These are the things for which [we] petition. Grant them for the honor of thy holy name, to which, with the Father and the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, thanksgiving, renown, and lordship for ever and ever. Amen.

The liturgical color next weekend is red. So I invite you to wear some red as an external expression of faith. Let us be open to the workings of the Holy Spirit in our lives and actively seek out His counsel in our lives that we may know what is ours to do while leading a good moral life. *Come Holy Spirit, and fill my heart with the fire of your love.*

**Ministry Fair Next Weekend** - *There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. (1 Cor. 12: 5 - 7)* Normally we would hold our annual Ministry Fair this weekend in conjunction with the Feast of Pentecost, but since it is Memorial Day weekend we will be hold it next weekend, June 3 & 4 in the school gym following all of the Masses. All of the parish organizations and ministries will have information available and members present to invite parishioners to share the gifts of the Holy Spirit given to them by God with the parish and the wider community.

**At the same time the Ministry Fair is a two way street.** What do I mean? I invite you to use the Ministry Fair as an opportunity to see how these same organizations, programs

and ministries could be a service to you or a loved one. After all, that is what this is about, service. Sometimes we do the serving and sometimes we make use of the services available.

On Saturday evening the Pastoral Council will provide complimentary pizza and beverages and on Sunday the Knights of Columbus will provide a free hot breakfast. Free will donations will be accepted to help the cover the cost of the food. I look forward to seeing you at the Ministry Fair!

**Memorial Day** - There will be one Mass at 8am on Memorial Day, May 29<sup>th</sup>. The Town of Berlin's Memorial Day Parade will step off from our school parking lot at 9am on its way the Veterans Memorial. The St. Paul Parish Center will be closed. Let us remember all who made the ultimate sacrifice for the cause of our freedoms. This day, more than any other, reminds us that freedom is not free.

## PASTOR'S COLUMN (continued)

**Corpus Christi Procession** - The Bishops of the United States have developed a three year program to reinvigorate our belief and understanding as Catholics in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. As Catholics we understand *Real Presence* to mean that in the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. The whole Christ is truly present - body, blood, soul, and divinity -- under the appearances of bread and wine, the glorified Christ who rose from the dead.

Beginning with the Feast of *Corpus Christi* (Latin for the Body of Christ) this year (June 10/11) and concluding in July 2024 there will be a special emphasis on this most sacred gift that Jesus has given us, His very self in the Eucharist. To begin this year-long celebration, we will hold a Eucharistic procession following the 4pm Vigil Mass on June 10 that will conclude under the gazebo on the Parish Green.

After the closing prayer at Mass there will be a procession with the Blessed Sacrament over to the gazebo where an altar will be set up. Some chairs will be set up underneath the gazebo. There will be a scripture reading and some prayers and some time for adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. We will conclude with Benediction at about 5:45pm depending on the length of the procession. Should the weather interfere, all will be held inside.

I encourage as many as possible to join in this prayer time to give glory and honor to Jesus in the Eucharist as well as to pray for yourself and your loved ones.

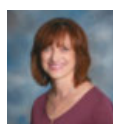

**PASTORAL COUNCIL** The May meeting of the Pastoral Council was held on Monday, May 15th. In attendance were Fathers Joe, Martin, and Michael, President Nancy Timbrell, Vice-President Mary Corrigan, Secretary Betty Lasker and council members Roland Baikal, Maura Chasse, Dwight Davis, Ron Levendaowsky, Fayne Malloy, Ed Schmitt, Tom Sullivan, and Bud Volz. Absent were Deacon Julio and Elaine Pavasaris. The opening prayer was offered by Fr. Joe.

Bud Volz gave a comprehensive presentation on the men's groups within the parish, focusing primarily on That Man Is You, an interactive men's program that combines the teachings of the Catholic faith and the wisdom of the saints in an effort to strengthen men to be more devoted to their faith, families, friends and community.

Jill Conaway presented a written report that highlighted a school whose enrollment has remained stable and updated resources and equipment continues to be provided so that our students receive a quality education. Due to the generosity of a benefactor, all classrooms will be equipped with new classroom furniture that will be delivered this summer. The finance committee is currently working on a plan to make our teachers' salaries more comparable to those in the public sector. This is necessary so as to recruit and retain the most qualified and dedicated educators available.

Dan Tome and Robin Veronesi each submitted reports highlighting the Youth Ministry and Religious Education Programs.

The Pastoral Council is in the process of forming subcommittees that will incorporate four areas of parish life: Spiritual Life and Worship, Evangelization and Faith Formation, Social Action, and Youth, Family, and Community Life. Members of the parish will also be on these committees in an effort to best assess the needs of the parish and the optimum methods of meeting those needs. More information will be forthcoming once the committees are finalized.

Father Joe indicated that tickets for the St. Roch's raffle should be received in parishioners' mailboxes the first or second week of June. Since we began participating in this raffle, the parish has netted over \$100,000 which helps to defray our ongoing expenses. Father Joe shared that both the parish and the school continue to be in good financial shape due to the generosity of parishioners and the hard work of the Finance Committees.

Father Joe explained that on the weekend of June 10th and 11th the parish will celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi. This will begin a year that will focus on a revitalization of our understanding of the Eucharist as the Real Presence of Jesus. Following the Saturday afternoon Mass, there will be a Eucharistic procession on Alling Street to the gazebo on the Parish Green where there will be music, prayer, and Benediction.

Council members received updates on the Home Front Project, the Parish Picnic (6/24), the upcoming Mass and Ice Cream Social on the Feast of St. Peter and St. Paul (6/29), the Berlin Fair, and the Scripture Study Groups. The closing prayer was offered by Father Martin. The next Pastoral Council Meeting is scheduled for June 19th at 7 pm. Parishioners are always welcome to attend.

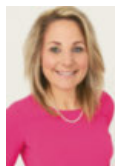
