





Follow Up on the Corpus Christi Procession - A special word of thanks to all who joined in our Eucharistic Procession following the 4:00pm Mass last weekend for the Feast of Corpus Christi. The 4th Degree Assembly of the Knights of Columbus provided an honor guard, and four members of our local Knights council carried the baldachin over the Blessed Sacrament. Many Extraordinary Ministers of Communion joined the procession as did one of our recent First Communicants, Madison. Members of the choir accompanied the many parishioners who then joined in following the Blessed Sacrament in the Procession. It is indeed symbolic of how we are to allow Jesus to lead us through this life. The procession also gave us the opportunity to give praise and worship to the Real Presence of Jesus as he was carried in procession. Many spoke of how it had been awhile since they had partaken in a Corpus Christi procession and how moving and meaningful it was for them. The procession was the first in a series of events over the coming year that will be designed to affirm and strengthen our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

What was that in the sanctuary last weekend? The canopy sitting in front of the statue of Mary last weekend is called a baldachin. As mentioned above, some of our local Knights carried it over the Blessed Sacrament while it was in procession outside the church building. Simply, a baldachin is a processional canopy that is square or rectangular made out of cloth and supported by four poles. The canopy, while not strictly required, adds dignity to the procession by making a sacred space for the Eucharist throughout the procession. This particular baldachin was made by a parishioner, Rita Beaulieu, a number of years ago while Fr. Herman was pastor and Fr. Michael was on his tour of duty here. 

"At the time in my life that I was asked to be a catechist I was feeling spiritually disconnected, so I began to pray and ask God for help to connect and give me something to bring me closer to him and church. So I went to sign my son up for religion. When I went inside the lady says to me, "Have you ever thought of teaching religion?" I quickly said, "Ohh no, never, I have no experience." She tells me, "It's fairly easy - the lessons are already set up for you," and again I shut her down and say, "No, I'm not interested; I'm not comfortable teaching." So she kindly says, "I have an idea. Why don't you take the lesson book home, at least look through it, and if you decide to teach, great! If not, return the books next week." So I agreed and walked. As soon as I sat in my car it hit so hard: This was God's calling!! I asked and prayed for weeks for something to bring me closer to him, so I took it as a sign from the Lord that this is what he wanted for me. It's been 4 years teaching and following my son's grade level. At times I question myself if the kids are learning and if I'm doing a good job, but one thing I'm sure of is I speak from my heart. My message is always the same: be kind, helpful, respectful to

each other, be remembered for love not hate. I feel blessed having this opportunity to share positivity with the kids. This journey connected me spiritually again. In your darkest moments God is always there and always talking to us, we just have to open our hearts and listen."


