



Religious Education Registration and Catechists Needed Information has been sent to all currently enrolled families and those whom census indicates have school age children. The deadline to register for this year's classes is this Monday, July 31st. Our Rel. Ed staff has much planning to do for the year so please adhere to the deadline. If your family has not received that information see page 5. We are in need of catechists. Might the Lord be calling you to share our faith with our children? Again see page 5 to let us know of your interest.

Hospital and Home Visits - Dozens of parishioners are visited by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Some of these visits are weekly while others are visited monthly by the Friars or when there is a specific request. How do we come to find out who to visit? In most cases it is because someone has contacted us to say that their mom or dad or relative or neighbor can no longer come to Mass. It is rare that the person themselves tells us this directly. Sometimes I might receive a note from someone who can no longer make it to Mass and that becomes an opportunity for me to call them and ask if they would like for someone to visit them and bring them Holy Communion. So if there is someone in your family who can no longer come to Mass please call the Parish Office (860-828-0331) or speak directly to one of the Friars. The same would be true for any of your friends or neighbors. At the very least we can reach out to them and offer to come and visit and bring Jesus to them. Likewise, if someone is in the hospital please let us know. Long gone are the days when we could go to the hospitals and simply look at a census for that day that would have included the name of their parish. The HIPPA privacy laws changed all of that years ago. Also, do not assume that someone else must have let us know because that person likely assumed somebody else had already called the parish. So how do we know who to visit? Someone just like you told us about them!

Outgoing Masters of Ceremonies - We are blessed to have so many young people serving at the altar. They will be recognized as each of their own last Masses come up in the coming weeks. The five (5) "retiring" MC and their college of choice are: Meghan Bresch (St. Anselm College), Anna Butrimas (Wheaton College), David Perkins (Tunxis Community College), R. J. 
