





So this weekend we pray for, ask God's blessings upon, and thank all of the catechists in our parish. I am so very grateful for the commitment and sacrifices that they make for our children. One of the keys to the success of such programs is dependent upon good leadership which we are so blessed to have in Mrs. Jill Conaway as Principal of St. Paul School and Mrs. Robin Veronesi who is so outstanding in her role as our Director of Religious Education. Pray too for the parents in their role as the first and most important catechist in the life of their child(ren).

Eucharistic Evening of Reflection with Steve Angrisano - Steve Angrisano is an internationally recognized Catholic composer, presenter and passionate music missionary. He has traveled around the world for over two decades sharing his unique blend of humor, story and song. Archbishop's Annual Appeal (AAA) - As of September 14th 496 parishioners/families have made a pledge or donation to the AAA, *His Sacrifice, and ours!*, totaling \$111,735. This takes us over our \$108,000 goal! It is 91% of our parish total last year which was \$122,750. It would be good if we can hit last year's total even while times are tougher because times are even tougher for those who have less. The average gift this year is \$225. Thus far this year there are 75 less donors than last year from our parish. Overall the AAA this year has raised a bit over \$8.5 million towards its goal of \$10 million. It is not too late to give. Remember all gifts, no matter the amount, will help provide for the needs of our less fortunate sisters and brothers in Christ. *Thank you for your generosity*.




