





New Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Readers are Needed - The parish is in need of additional Readers (Lectors) and Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) to serve in these ministries at Mass. There will be a day of reflection and training session for new members of these ministries on Sunday, October 15 from 1:15 to 5:15 pm in the St. Paul Church Hall. Volunteer Appreciation Open House - Our Volunteer Appreciation Open House will be held in three weeks on Sunday, October 29th following the 12 Noon Mass from 1-4 pm in the school gym. The event is meant to gather all parishioners who in any way assisted the parish in its various ministries and parish organizations during the past year. There will be food stations (think heavy hors d'oeuvres) as well as beer and wine. This is a self-invite event so that we do not inadvertently miss someone and cause hard **feelings.** Some may wonder why we host such an event. Some would say we do not volunteer to get something. I would concur, but it is always important to express appreciation and say thank you. In addition, this event is also meant to continue to foster us as a parish family and this gives parishioners the opportunity to get to know and mingle with their fellow parishioners. **Columbus Day/40 Days for Life -** Monday, October 9th is Columbus Day. Mass will be celebrated at 7 am only that day. There will be Eucharistic Adoration beginning after the 7 am Mass until 7:30 pm as part of the *40 Days for Life*. The Parish

Offices will be closed. See page 6 for information about the collection the Culture for Life Ministry is conducting in support of three pregnancy centers and the women they serve and their yet to be born child.

October Mass Count - Most (arch)dioceses, including the Archdiocese of Hartford, do Mass counts every October. So for the rest of the Sundays in October, the ushers will be counting how many people are in church as well as a count of those who receive Holy Communion. The counts help us and the archdiocese examine and understand any patterns that the statistics might show.

**2024 Mass Book -** Tier B opens this Wednesday October 11. Due to the large number of Mass intention requests, and so that as many parishioners as possible can have a reasonable opportunity to arrange to have a Mass said for their loved ones, parishioners will be limited to three (3) reserved dates per living or deceased person. These reserved dates may be three (3) weekday Masses or two (2) weekday and one (1) weekend Mass. Only one Mass per family is allowed on a weekend date. This restriction will be in place through November 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Trunk O' Treat -** Trunk O' Treat is scheduled for Saturday, October 21st! Everything that you need to know is on page 9 of the bulletin. So be creative and decorate your trunk and help provide our children with a safe and wholesome way to celebrate Halloween.

St. Clare's Pantry and Thanksgiving Food Collection - In addition to our regular food distribution every other Friday, the Social Action Committee also sponsors 30 families in Berlin to receive Thanksgiving Baskets. The contents of these baskets is a bit different and so on page 8 of the bulletin you can see the typical fixings that they are looking for to stock these baskets. The baskets will also include \$25 gift cards to purchase a turkey and other perishables as well. So you could also help by making a donation to cover part or all of one of those gift cards. The food for the Thanksgiving Baskets has to be at the Town of Berlin Food Bank by November 4. 'When did we see you hungry and feed you . . . when you did it for one of my least ones.' (cf. Mt. 25: 44-45)




