



PASTOR'S COLUMN

Please note that the printing deadline for this bulletin was December 13th.

Jesus is Born! - On Monday we will celebrate one of the most important days in the history of the world; that day God pierced the clouds and broke ever more intimately into our human existence by sending us His Son. Beginning with our Christmas Eve liturgies the liturgical season of Christmas begins. During this season, we celebrate the birth of Christ into our world and into our hearts.

As I write this, our local celebration of the 800th anniversary of the inaugural re-enactment of the first Christmas by St. Francis in Greccio last Sunday has not yet happened. Those who gathered with us last Sunday were given a commemorative of St. Francis at Greccio to hang on their tree at home, hopefully above or near their own manger scene. We have an additional supply of those keepsakes for each family as you leave Christmas Mass. I invite you to hang it on your tree. As you look upon your manger scene see how much God loves you that he would become one like us and take on our human nature.

In his 2009 Christmas homily Pope Benedict XVI said this: "God's sign is his humility. God's sign is that he makes himself small; he becomes a child; he lets us touch him and he asks for our love. How we would prefer a different sign, an imposing, irresistible sign of God's power and greatness! But his sign summons us to faith and love, and thus it gives us hope: this is what God is like. He has power, he is Goodness itself. He invites us to become like him. Yes indeed, we become like God if we allow ourselves to be shaped by this sign; if we ourselves learn humility and hence true greatness; if we renounce violence and use only the weapons of truth and love."

Still more wondrously Jesus continues to humble himself by coming to us each time we gather for Mass. He humbles himself over and over again as we recall his sacrifice on the cross. Every Eucharist is like Christmas where the bread and wine are transformed into His flesh, His Body and Blood, and, in a sense, He is born anew on the altar. Since September as a parish we have been participating in a year long Eucharistic renewal as we reflect on this greatest gift of Jesus himself in the Eucharist. To assist you in that reflection everyone will be given a book as a Christmas gift from the parish entitled, Beautiful Eucharist. Compiled by Matthew Kelly it is a collection of 12 personal reflections on the Eucharist by a variety of people and the impact that their belief in the Eucharist has had on their lives. In providing this book we hope it might provide a boost to your spiritual growth in the Lord and help you to reflect on the importance of the Eucharist in your own life. In the coming months we plan on scheduling some discussion sessions on the book.

As Jesus humbled himself to come to us, may we readily humble ourselves as we come to him each week recognizing how very much we need him in our lives; how much we need to be nourished and strengthened by His Body and Blood for this journey of life. In the name of all of the Friars, Deacon Don, and the entire staff of St. Paul Parish we wish everyone a very Blessed Christmas. If you are traveling we pray that your trip is safe and we look forward to you seeing you when you return. Merry Christmas!

When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, They took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord, and to offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons, in accordance with the dictate in the law of the Lord. Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, awaiting the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he should not see death before he had seen the Christ of the Lord. He came in the Spirit into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to perform the custom of the law in regard to him. He took him into his arms and blessed God. saying: "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." The child's father and mother were amazed at what was said about him: and Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted —and you yourself a sword will pierce—so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed." There was also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years, having lived seven years with her husband after her marriage, and then as a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple, but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer. And coming forward at that very time, she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem. When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.

Elena has out-of-state family that keeps in contact with her through daily phone calls and occasional visits during the year, but she does not get out of the house or see anyone other than her Helping Hands Volunteer on a regular basis. Having worked with Elena for so many years, our relationship has evolved from one of volunteer and senior into a beautiful

and genuine friendship.

During our weekly visits, Elena gets help with organizing and setting up her medications for the week and updating her calendar. As her eyesight diminishes, Elena needs more and



more help reading her mail, appointment cards and various instructional material. We help with that task.

A few years ago, we helped Elena arrange to receive Meals-on-Wheels services. Still, there are some favorite menu items and snacks that she likes to keep in the house, so every other Saturday, we get the groceries Elena likes to keep on hand. There are sometimes small household tasks that Elena can't do on her own. We are happy to help with those, also. Elena has not been able to drive for several years so she receives Holy Communion in her home. Being both a EMOHC and a Helping Hands volunteer has made it possible to bring Elena Holy Communion. We make those visits separate from the routine visits to keep them extra special. She particularly looks forward to these special visits.

Elena is very appreciative of the assistance Helping Hands is providing. She credits the Helping Hands Ministry with enabling her to remain in her home thus far, and bringing Our Lord's presence to her. Of course, we love knowing that we have had a positive impact on her life. It is truly a great feeling! We look forward to many more years of sharing this special friendship with Elena!


