



PASTOR'S COLUMN

Holy Week is Next Week - Included in this bulletin on page 5 is our complete schedule for Holy Week beginning with Palm Sunday. We will follow our regular Sunday schedule next weekend and palms will be distributed at all Masses. I encourage you to look over the Holy Week schedule carefully and plan now to enter into this very special time of prayer and reflection. Come and receive God's grace and be drawn deeper into the Paschal Mystery of the Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

Mercy Mondays - We have just two Mercy Mondays left this Lent. The Friars will be available to hear confessions from 7 pm to 8 pm. *I remind you that we also hear confessions every Saturday from 8:30 to 9:30 am and then again from 3:00 to 4:00 pm.* On the Mercy Mondays we also have Eucharistic Adoration. Come and spend some time in prayer.

Easter Memorials – All Easter Memorials must be received in the office by this Monday, March 18th to be included in the Easter bulletin. Memorials received after Monday will be printed in a subsequent bulletin. The Easter Memorials can also be submitted online.

St. Joseph Archdiocesan Medal of Appreciation - Last Sunday at the Cathedral of St. Joseph Archbishop Blair presided over the Archdiocese's annual conferral of the St. Joseph Medal of Appreciation. Each parish in the Archdiocese is invited to nominate an individual or a married couple over the age of 50 from among the laity who have given particular devotion and service to the parish over a number of years. Among the 122 recipients from 91 different parishes this year was our own Nancy Timbrell.



In announcing last year's recipient, Roz Durante, in this space, I commented that a parish like ours is blessed with dedicated volunteers who help in so many ways. Roz is an example of those volunteers who share their gifts quietly behind the scenes. Our parish is also especially blessed by those who are willing and very ably take on leadership positions in the parish. Nancy falls into this

category and does so in a very gracious and humble way. In 2017 when the Archdiocese sought to merge Sacred Heart Parish back into its mother parish of St. Paul, Fr. Robert, as Pastor, knew that for the merger to be as smooth as possible there would have to be key people to help the process along and Nancy Timbrell was one of those people. It was Nancy who became the President of the combined Pastoral Council. Having been very involved at Sacred Heart in many ways including in the office, Foodshare, the Berlin Fair, as well as

helping keep the parish's worship space in good order and nicely decorated (which she continues to lend a hand with) along with another St. Joseph Medal recipient, the late Maureen Guite, she helped shepherd the smooth transition to a combined Pastoral Council. She finished her time as President of the Council last year, but continues this year as an *ex officio* member as the immediate past President. She is an integral member of the leadership team for the Berlin Fair and gives leadership to the St. Clare Food Pantry and the distribution of those food items in conjunction with Foodshare. In addition, she serves as a volunteer in the Parish Center, is an active member of the Ladies Guild, and is a Greeter at our weekend liturgies. She was instrumental in the success of our



annual Ministry Fair. She is always ready to help with our social gettogethers including Coffee Ands, at both

worship sites, and can be found organizing and serving food at various parish events. In so many ways, regardless of what is going on, you will find Nancy offering a warm smile, a helping hand, and making every effort to make people fell welcome, listened to, and appreciated.

Nancy, thank you, for helping to unite and serve so many. Please join me in congratulating and thanking Nancy for her service to our parish!!
