

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Confirmations - This coming Saturday, April 20 our 10th graders will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at 11:00 am at the Cathedral of St. Joseph. Please pray for them in a particular way this week as they prepare to receive the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. As a result, we will not have any funerals on April 20.

First Holy Communions - On the weekend of May 4/5, our 3rd graders will be receiving their First Holy Communions at the 4:00 pm, 9:00 am and 12 Noon Masses. On the weekend of May 11/12, the First Communion Masses will be at the 4 pm and 10:30 am Masses. In all, there will be 91 children receiving their First Communions. There will be reserved pews at the front of both wings.

End of Life Care through a Catholic Lens - As I wrote last week, there might not be any more gut wrenching, morally challenging, and heart breaking decisions than those that sometimes come at the end of life, whether it be ours or of someone we love or in our role as a health care proxy. To help us with these decisions, our Culture of Life Ministry has invited Sister Catherine Mary Clarke, FSE to speak on next Monday, April 22nd in the St. Paul Church Hall at 6:30 pm to talk about caring for the terminally ill and/or aging loved ones. As a Franciscan Sister of the Eucharist she is a licensed clinical social worker. She is the primary social worker for Franciscan Home Care and Hospice Care in Meriden. Her presentation will include an open Question and Answer session. There is no cost and refreshments will be served. If you plan on attending, you are asked to sign up by April 20. See page 9 for the links. You can also sign up by calling the Parish Office at 860-828-0331 or by sending an email to respectlife@stpaulkensington.org. You do not need to do so to attend, but doing so will help us plan for seating and refreshments.


