

#### **PASTOR'S COLUMN**

Ministry Fair This Weekend - Like the apostles and the early members of the Church, we are also called to share the gifts and talents that God has given us for building up the Body of Christ and the Church. In the Vatican II document Lumen Gentium we read the following in paragraph 12: "The Holy Spirit not only sanctifies and guides God's people by the sacraments . . ., he also distributes special graces among the faithful of every state of life, assigning his gifts to each as he chooses. By means of these special gifts he equips them and makes them eager for various activities and responsibilities that benefit the Church in its renewal or its increase, in accordance with the text: To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for a good purpose." While we are very blessed with an active parish, life is constantly changing and no volunteer should feel that they have to do what they are doing forever. Likewise, those new to the parish or who now have more time or who are inspired by the Holy Spirit to use their gifts are welcome to become involved.

We have updated our ministry booklet and there will be one for everyone to take home and each ministry will have a handout as well. Take the information home and pray a bit about what the Lord might be asking you to do. No one needs to commit to anything at the Fair. There will be no hard sells or arm twisting, just an opportunity to learn more about your parish and see how you can share the gifts of the Holy Spirit for the building up of God's kingdom.

On Saturday evening the Pastoral Council will provide **complimentary** pizza and beverages and on Sunday the Knights of Columbus will provide a **free** hot breakfast. There will also be some door prizes as well for those who stop over. I look forward to seeing you at the Ministry Fair!

**Eucharistic Procession on June 1 -** The Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus, *Corpus Christi* in Latin, is June 2nd. Following the Saturday 4 pm Vigil Mass on June 1st, we will have an Eucharistic Procession with the Blessed Sacrament. We began our Eucharistic Renewal year last June in a similar way. Why have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament? Pope Benedict XVI said: "The procession is a profession of faith . . . and the procession is a public statement of that belief. The sacrament of the Lord's Body and Blood always "goes above and beyond the walls of our churches." The procession blurs the separation between what we do inside the church, and what we do outside: we immerse Christ, so to speak, "in the daily routine of our lives, so that he may walk where we walk and live where we live."

Our procession route this year will go out the old wing, down Peck Street, into the parking lot, to the back of the school, across the street to the gazebo and then back into the church. We will make three stops for prayers and song along the way

and there will be prayer and song that accompanies us as we process and we will conclude with Benediction in the church. If some felt that walking in procession was too much, they could wait in church. If you want to go to your "regular" Mass, you could join us just for the procession and Benediction. Come and give praise and worship to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament by joining in the Procession. Pray for yourself and the intentions of your loved ones. It is the Eucharist that strengthens us to be the Lord's disciples and to seek to follow him while living in this world.

First Communicants - Congratulations to the 90 students from our Religious Education program and Saint Paul School who received their 1st Holy Communions over the last two weekends! We pray that their love of Jesus in the Eucharist will grow with each time they receive him, which we pray will be weekly. Join me in thanking all of those who helped them prepare for this very special moment including our 3rd grade teacher in the school, Kari Buchholz, as well as our 3rd grade catechists in our Religious Education Program: Suzanne Ciarcia, Lisa Moscaritolo and Kara Satalino. We are hoping that a number of our 1st Communicants and their families will join in the Eucharistic Procession that I wrote about above.

Sharing Our Faith With Our Youth - Over the last few weeks more than 150 of our younger parishioners received either their 1st Communions or were Confirmed. I have noted above and in previous columns those who had a direct hand in preparing them to receive these sacraments. But I also want to thank the parents for continuing to pass down the gift of faith to their children. Surely that is not always easy, but without doubt it is the most precious gift that you can give to your children. May God continue to bless you in your responsibilities as parents. Likewise, thanks to those who are god-parents for them and all those who were sponsors for the *confirmandi*. May God's grace help you to continue to accompany them in their lives of faith.

Yet there are still others who deserve our prayers and appreciation. Our Director of Religious Education, Mrs. Robin Veronesi, does such an exemplary job in leading our entire Religious Education program and the more than 570 students and dozens of catechists who make up the program along with other volunteers. No small part of that job are all of the logistics that go into making sure that the Confirmation and 1st Communions are prayerful and at the same time run smoothly and efficiently. Robin has been assisted very capably by a new assistant this year, Mrs. Linda Beaudin. As Pastor and as a parish we are very blessed to have such faithful, dedicated, and hardworking people ministering to our youth. Whisper an extra prayer for them in gratitude for all that they do.








Our staff is now preparing next year's schedule and curriculum. Online registration for the 2024-2025 school year will launch on July 15, 2024.


On Pentecost, as we recognize the courage that the Holy Spirit gives all of us to step out in faith, consider whether God is calling you to be a catechist.


