PASTOR'S COLUMN

Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession on June 1 - The purpose of our year-long Eucharistic Renewal, which draws to a close in July, was to help us focus on the gift of Jesus Himself in the Eucharist and to help each of us appreciate and value how central the Eucharist is as "the source and summit of the Christian life". On Holy Thursday 2003 Pope John Paul II in his encyclical *Ecclesia de Eucharistia* said, "The Church draws her life from the Eucharist... Consequently the gaze of the Church is constantly turned to her Lord, present in the Sacrament of the Altar, in which she discovers the full manifestation of his boundless love."

We began our local Eucharistic Renewal by re-introducing a Eucharistic Procession on the Feast of *Corpus Christi*. This practice can be traced in the Church to the 13th century and so we will do so again this year following the 4:00 pm Vigil Mass on June 1. Pope Benedict XVI in a homily in 2007 said the Eucharistic procession "was born for the very precise purpose of openly reaffirming the faith of the people of God in Jesus Christ, alive and truly present in the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist. It is a feast that was established in order to publicly adore, praise and thank the Lord, who continues 'to love us to the end,' even to offering us his body and his blood."

After the closing prayer at Mass, the procession with the Blessed Sacrament will go out the old wing, down Peck Street, into the parking lot, to the back of the school, across the street to the gazebo and then back into the church. We will make three stops for prayers along the way and there will be song that accompanies us as we process. We will conclude with Benediction in the church. If some felt that walking in procession was too much they could wait in church. If you want to go to your "regular" Mass you could join us just for the procession and Benediction. Come and give praise and worship to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament by joining in the procession and pray for yourself and your loved ones.

Ministry Fair Recap - Let me begin by thanking everyone who stopped over and visited our Ministry Fair last weekend.
