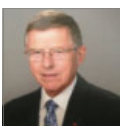

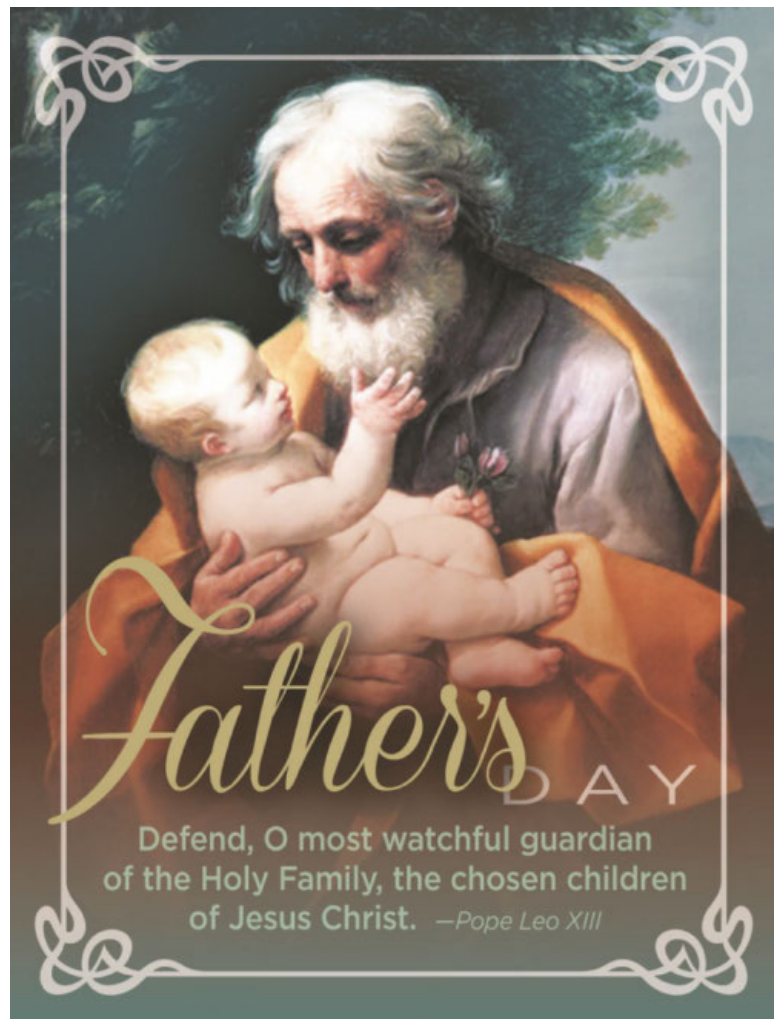

Called By Name - As was addressed at all of the Masses last weekend, we are participating in the *Called By Name* vocation discernment program this weekend. This is an Archdiocesan wide effort to bring forth the names of people you recognize as potentially having the qualities that one might need to be a priest or religious. There are many vocations that never see the light of day simply because someone never invited the person to consider the idea.

This initiative does not include just young men, or a bit older, called to the priesthood whether that be as a Diocesan priest or one called to a Religious Order, like the Franciscans who serve here at St. Paul. This also includes young women, or again those a bit older, who are called to Religious life as a Sister in the many different communities of religious women. It also includes someone who you think would be a good candidate to be a Permanent Deacon. Let us recall that ultimately it is God who calls someone. However, recall too that God makes use of many people and means to accomplish His plans. You might be the person God wants to use to call someone forth to serve Him and His church as a Religious priest, sister, or brother or as a diocesan priest.

There are cards in the pews that can be used to submit a person's name because you see something in them that they should consider that God might be calling them to a life of ministry in the Church. It is more difficult these days, I think, for young people to recognize God's calling even if they have thought about it, even if it was just briefly. Having someone else reinforce that calling can be very significant. A person

who is nominated does not need to make any commitments. They will receive a letter from Archbishop Coyne or others congratulating them on living a good Christian life and having their name brought forth. They will then be invited to begin a process to discern the call of the Lord in their life. To submit a name you can also use the QR code on one of the cards and do it electronically. So please seriously and prayerfully consider who you might nominate and thus help God plant a seed and begin the birth of a vocation to ministry in the Church.

Parish Family Mass and Picnic - Our annual Parish Family Mass and Picnic is this coming Saturday, June 22nd. We will begin with Mass at 4:00 pm on the Parish Green followed by the Picnic. **For those who are new to the parish, or have not attended in the past, this is a free event.** There is plenty to do for the kids. The food will be great as it always is including hamburgers, hot dogs, kellys, salads, deserts and much more. Remember to bring a lawn chair for Mass! There is a big tent, but not everyone will be able to be seated under the tent for Mass. There will be some chairs set up for Mass, but it is helpful if you can leave those for whom it is not easy to bring their own chair. **A new addition this year is a Corn Hole Tournament.** It costs \$10 to get into the tournament with the proceeds going to the winners. The Committee could use some extra hands to help everything run smoothly. See page 7 or go to the parish website for how you can by volunteering, donating for some of the raffle baskets that will help offset some of the cost and of course your delicious deserts!! Whisper a little prayer for good weather too!! Hope to see you there!!

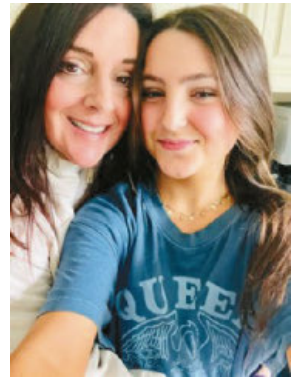

Called By Name Sunday at St. Paul Parish

At all Masses during the weekend of June 15/16, St. Paul and Sacred Heart Church will participate in the **Called By Name** vocation discernment process as part of an Archdiocesan wide initiative.

Called by Name recognizes that many vocations to the priesthood and religious life are never realized simply because no one has ever invited potential candidates to answer God's calling. **Called By Name** changes that. To begin the discernment process, we ask that you please use these next two weeks to think of those young people whom you know who demonstrate qualities which may indicate a possible vocation to priesthood (either to the Franciscan or Diocesan priesthood) or to consecrated life as a sister or brother.

Then you will be asked to share some simple information (i.e. name, age, email address, home parish, etc.) regarding the name(s) of those whom you think may have a calling to be a priest or sister. Information cards and pencils will be provided in all the church pews the weekend of **June 15/16**.

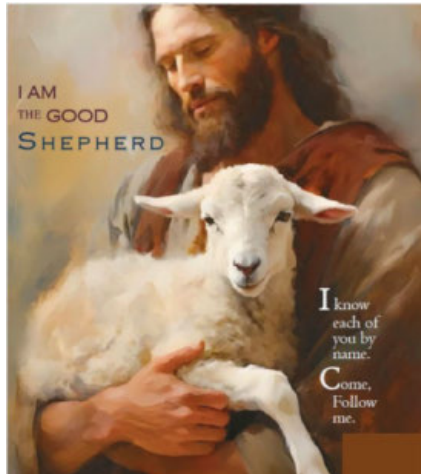
You will also be able to use the QR code on the card to nominate a person electronically if you prefer. Fill in as much of the information as you are able i.e. school, age, email address, phone number etc. Don't worry if you can't provide it all. Members of the Parish Vocations Committee will try their best to fill in as much information as they can.

Called by Name cards will be collected via the parish collection baskets at offertory time.

A person who is nominated does not need to make any commitments. They will receive a letter from Archbishop Coyne congratulating them on living the Christian life in an exemplary way and be invited to begin discerning God's calling through the Vocations Office in the normal way if they choose to do so.

Other dioceses which have done **Called By Name** have reported astonishing numbers of new priests and religious sisters or brothers simply by inviting them to begin the discernment process. Please take some prayerful moments in the coming weeks to think who you might nominate as person who you think might have a calling from God.

Imagine if this was the moment a vocation to the priesthood or religious life began because you made it so that this person could be **Called by Name**. . .



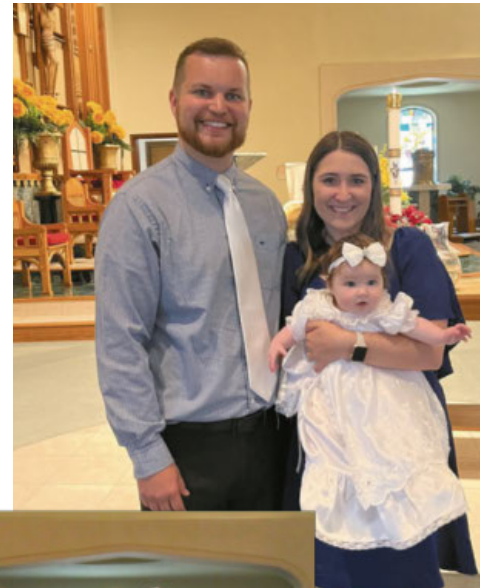

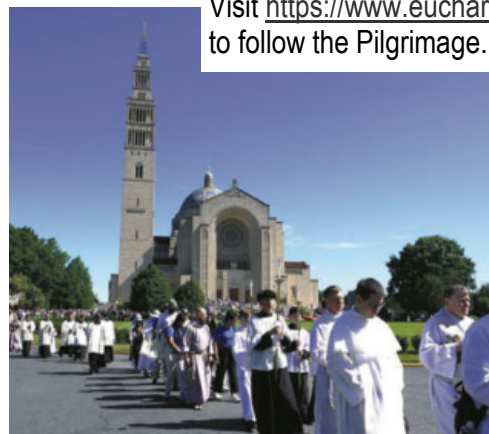


NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE

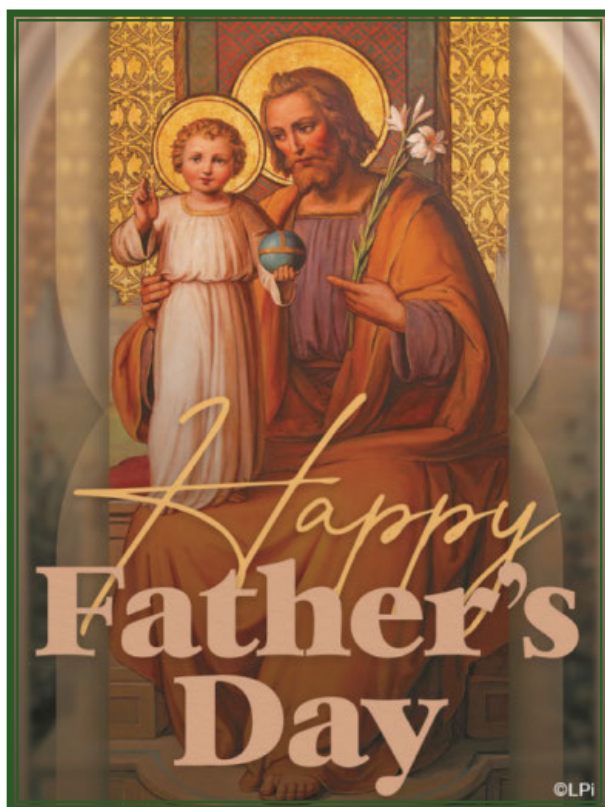

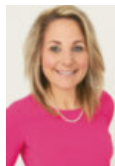
