



Topic: The Shroud of Turin

The Shroud of Turin is believed to be the cloth in which Jesus' body was wrapped after his Crucifixion. The linen sheet features the image of a man who bears the marks of flagellation and crucifixion. Many consider the Shroud to be one of Christianity's most important relics.



The Shroud of Turin has been located in Turin, Italy since the 1500s. The cloth which measures over 14 feet long contains "a front and back image of a man that was crucified exactly as the New Testament says that Jesus of Nazareth was crucified, yet the image contains no pigment." https://www.shroudressarch.net

Guest Speaker: Deacon Alan Germain

Deacon Alan received a Master of Arts in Theology from Holy Apostles College and Seminary in 2009. He was Ordained to the Permanent Diaconate for the Archdiocese of Hartford in 2012, and he is currently assigned to St. Marian Cope Parish in East Windsor, Connecticut.

He first became interested in the Shroud of Turin in 1981 and completed Postgraduate Certificate courses on the Shroud at Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum in Rome in 2018.

Deacon Alan has researched the Shroud for many years and will share his extensive knowledge and insights about this mysterious artifact with us! Don't miss it!
