





RELIGIOUS EDUCATION


Now that classes have concluded and our First Communion and Confirmation students have received their sacraments, our focus shifts to preparations for the 2025-2026 school year.

Online registration for Grade 1-10 opens July 15.

An email with the link will be sent to this year's families. Continuous instruction from first grade through Confirmation is expected to receive the sacraments. Homeschooling is an option for all years except the sacrament preparation years.

The sacrament of Baptism is the gateway to all the other sacraments. Also, prior to being Confirmed, a young person must also have received the Sacrament of Holy Communion.

The Special Sacraments program is for any child who has not received the sacraments of Baptism prior to third grade and/or First Reconciliation and First Communion in third grade. 




