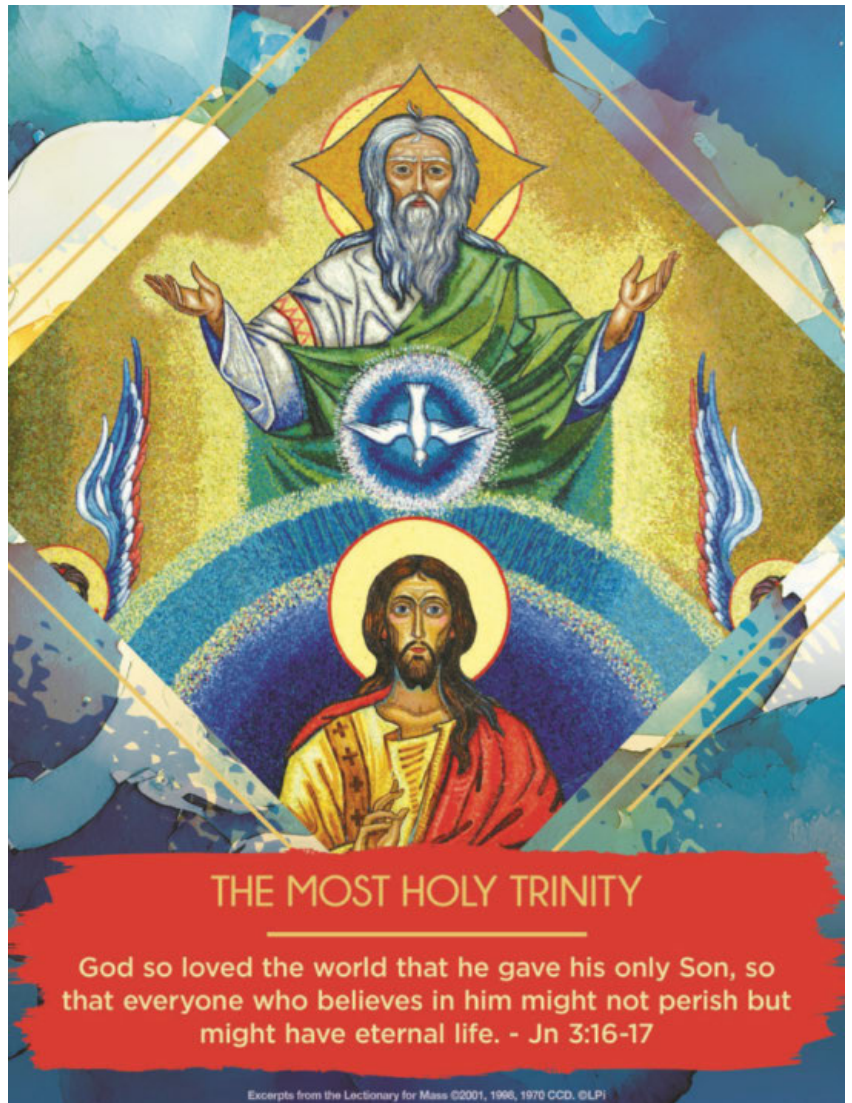

HOLY TRINITY “In God we see the Father—the “being one” and first principal of life in the Godhead—the Son—the “knowing one”—the Word who proceeds from the Father—and the Holy Spirit—the “willing one”—the bond of love between the Father and Son who proceeds as love from the Father and Son. These “three” do not “equal” one if we are trying to say $3=1$ mathematically. These three are distinct realities, relationally speaking, just as my own being, knowing, and willing are three distinct realities in me. Yet, in both God and man these three relationally distinct realities subsist in one being.”

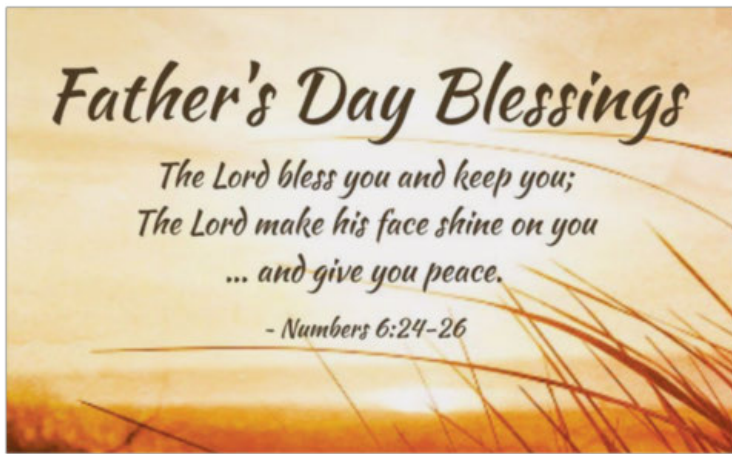

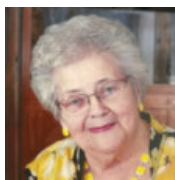
In Loving Memory

The parish would like to express its condolences to all who mourn the loss of Phyllis Fecteau. Phyllis passed away on June 4, 2025.



Phyllis was a dedicated and selfless member our St. Paul Parish community, donating her time and talent in a myriad of ways over a period of more than 65 years. She created our Rosary Makers Ministry which is still making Rosary Beads today.

Below is an excerpt from her obituary:



Phyllis Theresa (Paradis) Fecteau, 95, of Kensington, beloved wife of the late Clement J. Fecteau, entered eternal rest with her family by her side, on Wednesday, June 4, 2025.

Phyllis joined St. Paul Church, in 1958, she gave generously of her time and labor. She used to starch and iron the church linens, she was a lector, usually at the Saturday, 4 p.m. mass, she was a money counter for the church's weekend mass donations, she was awarded the "St. Joseph Metal" in 2006. In 1989 she created the "St. Paul's Rosary Makers" mission, where they handmade well over one million rosaries over the years. She loved baking and would make decorated cakes for the friar's birthday. Her faith and service were constant; it was a labor of love. St. Paul Parish held a sacred place in her heart."

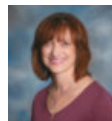

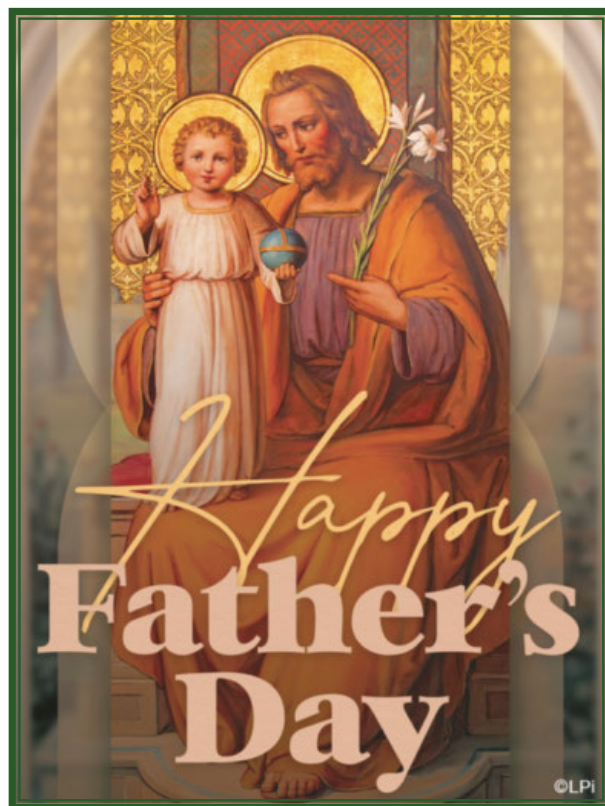
