### JOSEPH, THE ACCEPTING FATHER

*Pope Francis writes:*

The spiritual path that Joseph traces for us is not one that explains but accepts. Only as a result of this acceptance, this

reconciliation, can we begin to glimpse a broader history, a deeper meaning.

Joseph is certainly not passively resigned, but courageously and firmly proactive. In our own lives, acceptance and welcome can be an expression of the Holy Spirit's gift of fortitude. Only the Lord can give us the strength needed to accept life as it is, with all its contradictions, frustrations and disappointments.

"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore, we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea. The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. He says, 'Be still, and know that I am God.'" (Psalms 46:1-10)

Joseph had to confront circumstances and events that he never had imagined and certainly had never planned for. Yet he was able to accept them, deal with them, and seek ways to respond. He trusted that God was with him and would lead, guide and strengthen him for whatever trial or challenge he was confronting. This trust allowed for new paths, new possibilities to open up.

*When your plans are upended, have you had an experience of God "making things new" in a way you would never have expected? Can you cultivate in you the response of the Psalmist to "be still and know that I am God"? What is it life for you to "be still" and let God be God? Ask Saint Joseph for the grace to always trust as he did in God's presence and guidance no matter.*

### SIN ON THE SOUL

#### QUESTION:

*Why do some sacraments leave a character or mark on the soul? Don't all sacraments affect the soul?*

#### ANSWER:

All sacraments mediate

grace and connect us to Christ and to the Church. Some sustain us in our faith journey, while others help us heal from the effects of sin. Each one offers a share in God's life, giving us what we need to be faithful followers of Jesus. But some sacraments change us in ways that are irreversible. The three sacraments that leave a character are Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders. We are literally different people because of the effect of the grace of those sacraments. We are changed at the core of our being in such a fundamental way that we can not go back to what we once were.

In Baptism, we are freed from original sin, initiated into the Body of Christ as adopted sons and daughters. In Confirmation, we are given the fullness of God's Spirit, sealed in his grace and gifted with what we need to live a Christian life. In Holy Orders, a priest is marked as an 'alter Christus,' another Christ, and is once and forever a priest who offers sacrifice, forgives sin, and acts in the person of Christ. In these three sacraments, we are conformed more closely to Christ, reflecting his love and truth. ©LPi


