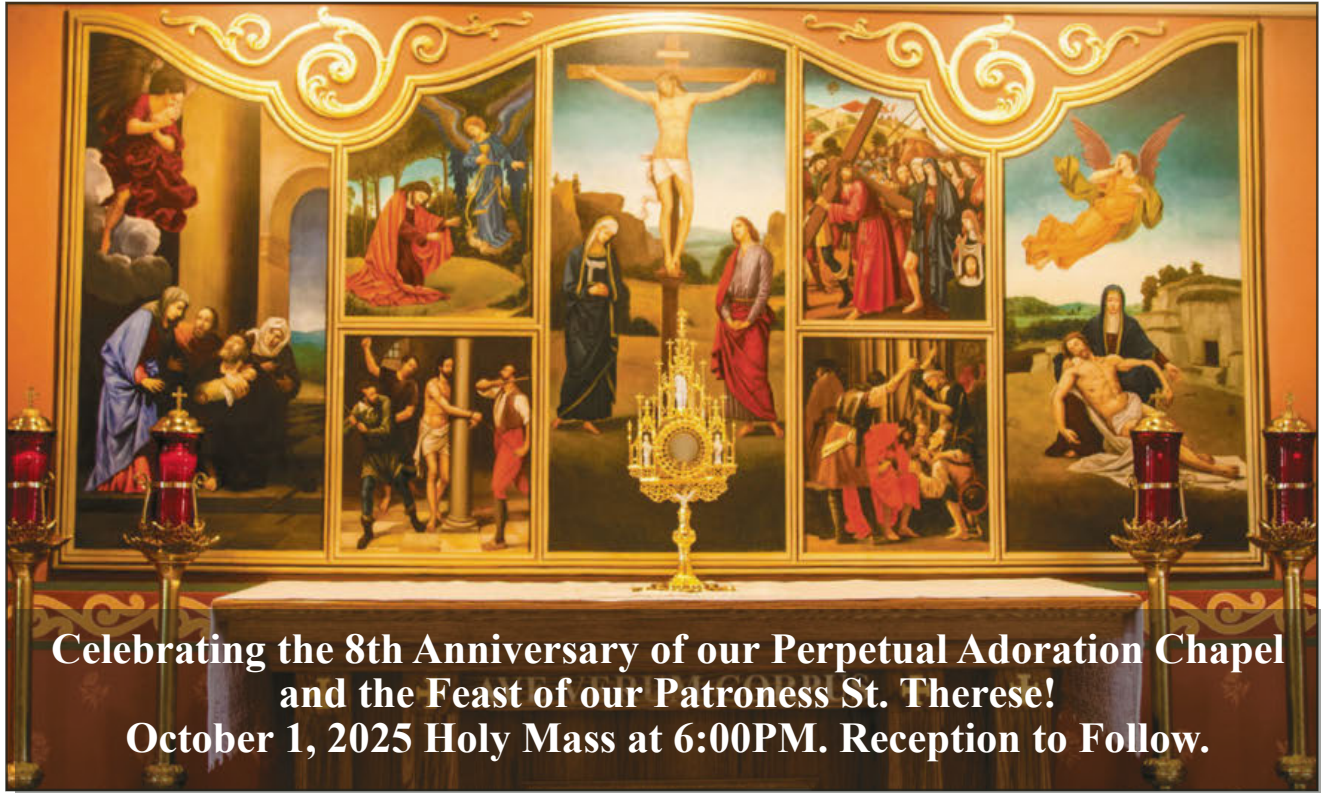

— Guidelines Sponsors —

Any parishioner of St. Theresa who wishes to act as a godparent for the Sacrament of Baptism or as a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, must contact the Parish Office to arrange a brief appointment with the Pastor. One must be a registered and active parishioner with St. Theresa for at least 3 months.

To act as a sponsor a Catholic must:

1. Be at least 16 years of age, unless the pastor judges otherwise for a just cause;
2. Be mature enough to undertake this responsibility;
3. Have received all three sacraments of initiation, (Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation);
4. If married, married according to Catholic teaching;
5. Regularly attend Mass Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.

— From The Pastor's Desk —

The “Domestic Church” is an important theme found throughout John Paul II’s writings. It is a theme that echoes from the early days of the Church. What does it mean? Simply put, that all that is taught and prayed about in Church is first put into action in the home. Making Jesus Christ the center of the home must come first, and if so, brings enormous treasure to that family.

Where can we discover good examples of this? In the lives of the saints. We especially think of St. Padre Pio, whose feast day was this past Tuesday, September 23rd! We know that St. Padre Pio (1887-1968) was born to a family that was very poor, yet their Catholic faith was at the center. The rosary was said every day. They went to daily Mass, and even fasted from meat three times a week! Padre Pio’s grandparents could not read or write, but that did not stop them from memorizing bits of sacred Scripture and repeating them lovingly to their grandchildren. Mother Frances Xavier Cabrini’s father would read the lives of the saints to his 13 children every evening, thus instigating a fire inside her that would motivate her exploits to help immigrants and orphans all over the new world, all centered on Jesus Christ.

It becomes an excellent inspiration to us that, by following their example, we can create holy warriors as well in our own homes. The world today provides enormous distractions to youth to get them to think about anything except God, hence the need for the home to become a sanctuary where children can live and breathe the goodness of God. There is no more valuable time spent with children than talking about God. At the dinner table, inside the car, at bedtime, anywhere, when we speak about the saints to children as the greatest heroes of all, we help connect them to the deepest desire of their souls, which is to imitate Christ.

Family prayer is crucial to the development of children. If a child grows up praying with his mother and father on a regular basis, they learn that everyone needs God, and that the most important people in their lives depend greatly on God. They will learn that communicating with God becomes a source of strength and power. No better way to spend family time than with Christ in adoration. Plus, children need to learn these ancient forms of prayer that bring so much strength to the soul.

Another powerful way of forming children and strengthening families is to come to confession together. Children need to see their parents entering the confessional, as it will greatly impact them to understand the powerful necessity of confession. How Our Lord forgives us and picks us right back up! We all need confession; the greatest of saints like Mother Teresa went once a week. The person who does not think they need confession is a person who does not understand our Lord’s great mercy.

In the end, the children that go to Holy Mass every Sunday, go to confession regularly, pray together with their parents, are children that will have deeper bonds with their parents, and will grow up better prepared for the difficulties of life. Without Christ at the center, children easily drift into false pleasures of this world. With Jesus Christ at the center of the home, the home becomes a true sanctuary for children, a true refuge and source of strength. Such a home will forge deeper bonds between all who live within.

Please join us Wednesday, October 1st, to celebrate both the great feast of St. Therese our patroness, and the 8th anniversary of the Perpetual Adoration chapel! 6:00pm Holy Mass with beautiful music and reverent worship. Afterwards a wonderful dinner in the gym with an ice cream sundae bar as well!! We thank especially our head coordinator Dr. Amy, many shift coordinators, over 300 guardians and hundreds of visitors! Also, profound thanks to our picnic committee for a wonderful Parish picnic two weeks ago! Hundreds of hamburgers and hot dogs, many pounds of sausage and peppers, as well as great games, a tremendous DJ, all emblematic of the great generosity of so many here at our beloved parish!

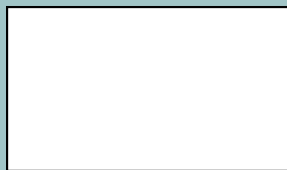
