



BATISMO DO SENHOR

"TU ÉS O MEU FILHO AMADO,
EM TI PONHO O MEU BEM-QUERER" (LC 3,22)



Celebramos, neste domingo, a festa do Batismo do Senhor, concluindo o tempo do natal. O evangelho proposto é (Lc 3,15-16.21-22.) Apesar de não precisar submeter-se a este ritual, pois Nele não havia pecado algum Jesus saiu da Galiléia a fim de ser batizado por João Batista, no rio Jordão. Jesus, que não tinha pecados, confirmou a Sua Filiação pela unção do Espírito Santo e consequentemente a nossa filiação. Portanto, o Batismo de Jesus tem para nós o significado da justiça que o Pai planejou nos conceder com o objetivo de que também nos tornássemos Seus filhos e filhas amados. A filiação atestada pelo próprio Pai deve ser relacionada com a filiação humana. Com o Batismo, Sua Morte na Cruz e Ressurreição Jesus inaugurou para nós um novo tempo de justiça e graça: somos filhos eleitos de Deus. No Batismo de Jesus nós encontramos a estrutura da Santíssima Trindade: A Voz do **Pai**, a Manifestação do **Espírito Santo** em forma de pomba e o Título de **Filho** de Deus amado. No nosso Batismo a Voz do Pai se faz ouvir revelando o Seu grande amor por nós quando nos concede o Seu Espírito Santo e nos adota como filhos no Seu Filho amado. No nosso Batismo também o Pai deu testemunho do Seu Amor por nós: "Tu és o meu filho, a minha filha amada"! Logo, somos irmãos de Jesus Cristo, adotados por causa da Sua Morte e Ressurreição. Não podemos ser pessoas abatidas nem deprimidas, pois o mesmo Espírito que está em Jesus mora também em nós. Se verdadeiramente nos apossarmos dessa graça de filiação, com certeza não teremos nenhuma dúvida de que somos filhos e filhas apreciadas por Deus que nos olha com carinho e está atento às nossas necessidades.

– Você tem consciência da grande graça que recebeu no Batismo? – Você também se considera um filho, uma filha amada por Deus Pai? – Pare um pouquinho para escutar a voz que vem do céu apresentando você ao mundo como filho (a) amado (a). Você acredita nisto? Deus abençõe você.






