

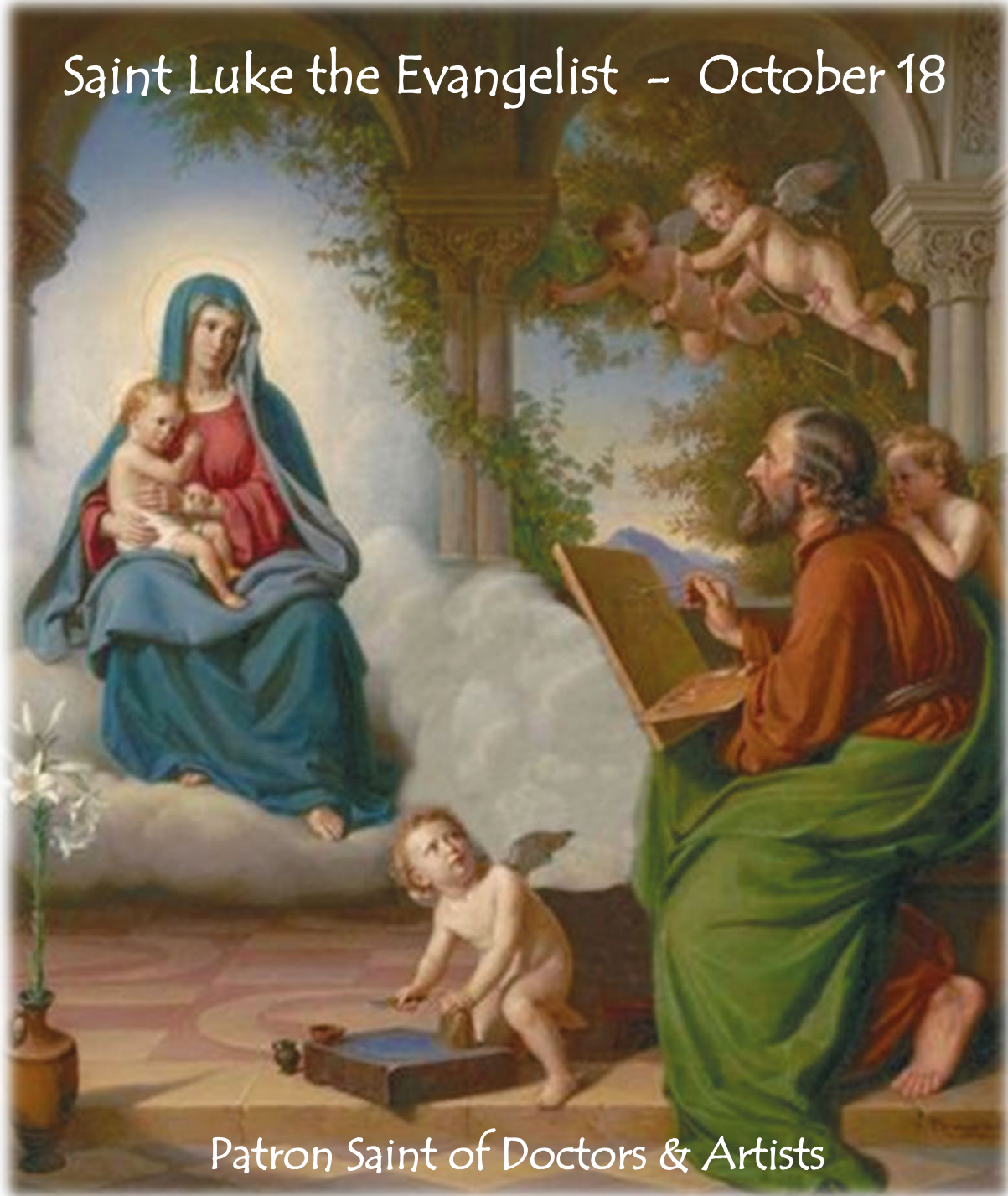

EVANGELHO (Lc 18, 1-8)

Os personagens centrais da parábola (vers 2-5) são uma viúva e um juiz. A viúva, pobre e injustiçada, passava a vida a queixar-se do seu adversário e a exigir justiça; mas o juiz, “que não temia Deus nem os homens”, não lhe prestava qualquer atenção... No entanto, o juiz apesar da sua dureza e insensibilidade acabou se por fazer justiça à viúva, a fim de se livrar definitivamente da sua insistência importuna. O juiz da parábola faz justiça, não para fazer respeitar a justiça, mas para ter a paz. É a perseverança da mulher que lhe faz obter o que ela pede. O que conta aos olhos do Senhor é a perseverança no pedido. Deus parece esperar a confiança daqueles que

Lhe rezam. A confiança não tem limites... Mas Jesus coloca a terrível questão: “O Filho do Homem, quando vier, encontrará fé sobre a terra?” Não respondamos demasiado depressa... A nossa oração verifica a nossa fé, mas é necessário que ela se faça perseverança... Lucas pede aos cristãos a quem a mensagem se destina que, apesar do aparente silêncio de Deus, não deixem nunca de dialogar com Ele. É nesse diálogo que entendemos os projetos e os ritmos de Deus; é nesse diálogo que Deus transforma os nossos corações; é nesse diálogo que aprendemos a entregar-nos nas mãos de Deus e a confiar n’Ele. Sobretudo, que nada (nem o desânimo, nem a desconfiança perante o silêncio de Deus) nos leve a desistir de uma verdadeira comunhão e de um profundo diálogo com Deus.

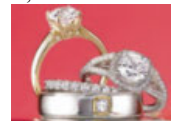
