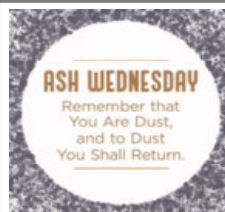

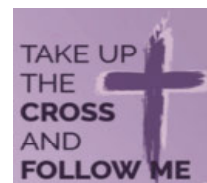

FAITH CORNER



Ash Wednesday and Lent. Ash Wednesday is one of the most popular and important holy days in the liturgical calendar. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a season of penance,

reflection, and fasting through which we attain redemption.

Ash Wednesday takes place 46 days before Easter Sunday, and is chiefly observed by Catholics, although many other Christians observe it too and comes from the ancient Jewish tradition of penance and fasting. The practice includes the wearing of ashes on the head as a visible symbol of penance. The ashes are made from blessed palm branches, taken from the previous year's Palm Sunday Mass and they symbolize the dust from which God made us. As the priest applies the ashes to a person's forehead, he speaks the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

Lent is the 40-day period preceding Easter that focuses on remembering the death and resurrection of Jesus. (Sundays aren't included, but it's actually 46 days if you count them.) This six-week period includes a renewed perspective on baptism, which often means a recommitment of faith. During Lent, people often fast or give up something special to them (often a food indulgence), attend Stations of the Cross or a Lenten mission. All of which prepares their hearts and minds for Easter, the day of Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.
