

I was able to visit nine of the ten masses last weekend. I missed the 11:00 am Mass at Mount Carmel which I am celebrating this weekend. Thank you for your warm welcome, I appreciate your kind words. For the record, I am still missing my boots, some pants, and my warm winter hats. I have found my oatmeal though, so breakfast is not being affected by the move.

I am still on track for meeting with various people in the parish community. The Finance Councils Meeting took place after I wrote this letter but before you read it. We are in the process of figuring out a time for a meeting of the Pastoral Councils. These meetings are important as we try to figure out the foundations of our new parish.

I am planning on meeting with our school staff again after I write this letter but before you read it. I am also planning on meeting with our Faith Formation Staff this week. Our parish is fortunate for the wonderful value that has been placed on Catechesis by those who have gone before us. Catechesis is a wonderful way to evangelize. Our lessons that are imparted either in the school or in the faith formation programs are lessons that stay with people for their lives. In my own life, I remember Sister Jean's gentle voice and teaching as she prepared me for First Communion so many years ago. Our preparing our youngest parishioners and their families in the faith is not an afterthought or something extra that we do; rather it is a clear response to God's call in sharing the Word. I am grateful to our schools and their staffs and to our Faith Formation programs and their staffs for the important work they do for us each day.

This is a time of transition: as much as I am centered on the fact that it is a challenging time for me, I can just imagine how much of a challenge it is for all of you. These past years have seen much change here in Hamden. Change is difficult and sometimes irksome; I certainly appreciate the challenge to all of you of the reconfigurations that have happened in the past. At this moment we start anew together, I would like you to move forward with me as we create this new parish.

St. Paul VI wrote: The task of evangelizing all people constitutes the essential mission of the Church. It is a task and mission which the vast and profound changes of present-day society make all the more urgent. Evangelizing is in fact the grace and vocation proper to the Church, her deepest identity. She exists in order to evangelize. (Apostolic exhortation: On evangelization in the modern world, December 8, 1975)

Our task as our new parish is to Evangelize: to proclaim Christ to a world that so desperately needs to hear it. As we form ourselves as a parish, may our work together bring more people to God. Our responsorial psalm today invites us to "Proclaim his marvelous deeds to all the nations." This proclamation is a task that each of us shares. In our ensuing weeks, months, dare I say years, let us work together to build the Church here in Hamden.

Thank you for all you do for our parish.
