

Dear Friends,

I am adjusting to my new life here in Hamden. I have been moved by the many positive and warm words of welcome that I have received. I continue my quest to celebrate all the different Masses we celebrate here at St. Paul VI. (For the record we celebrate 10 Masses in our four churches each weekend!)

Our Finance Committees meeting went well. I always trust the wise advice of those whose lives are so connected to our Catholic life. We have a preliminary budget for the new church and we will be tweaking it as we form the new Finance Council for the parish. A budget as we all know is more than a simple financial document: it is a statement of values and beliefs for it defines what the priorities of our new parish will be. I take that very seriously.

Our meeting of the parish Councils was also successful. I was able to hear the passion and the dedication of a large swath of Hamden Catholics as we discussed our foundation of the new parish. The session's purpose was for me to listen to members of our community. No decisions were made, nor even entertained. But, the listening is an important component of ministry. I learned from everyone who shared. In a non-COVID world we would have a parish meeting; I will be announcing next week ZOOM meetings for us to get to know each other.

I will be meeting with our deacons soon. They truly are the unsung heroes of our church. I have been involved over the years in the diaconate formation program as an instructor and a spiritual director; in fact two of our deacons are my former students. These clergymen who also are part of the world give a witness to God's presence in a wonderful way. Thank your deacons this weekend!

One of the wonderful facts of life here in Hamden are the opportunities for Eucharistic adoration. We have Adoration each Monday at St. Rita Church from 8:00 am - 4:00 am, as well as First Fridays from 8:00 am until 7:00 pm. At Blessed Sacrament Church we have adoration on First Fridays from 7:00 pm until 8:00 pm. On Mondays, Mount Carmel Church has adoration from 6:00 pm - 7:00 pm. Adoration is a wonderful time for us to gather in the presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament and recollect and renew.

Presently there are a variety of times on Saturdays for Confession. Saturday confessions make sense in parishes with only one Mass on a Saturday, but here in Hamden we presently have three Masses on Saturday evening plus weddings and funerals. **Starting Monday January 24, we will be having Confessions for the parish from 6:00 pm until 7:00 pm at Mount Carmel Church.** This will replace all the other confession times. This will be during Eucharistic Adoration. In parishes across the archdiocese we have seen an increase in the number of confessions by changing the times to a weeknight evening. Please join us for this wonderful opportunity to place ourselves before the Lord in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
