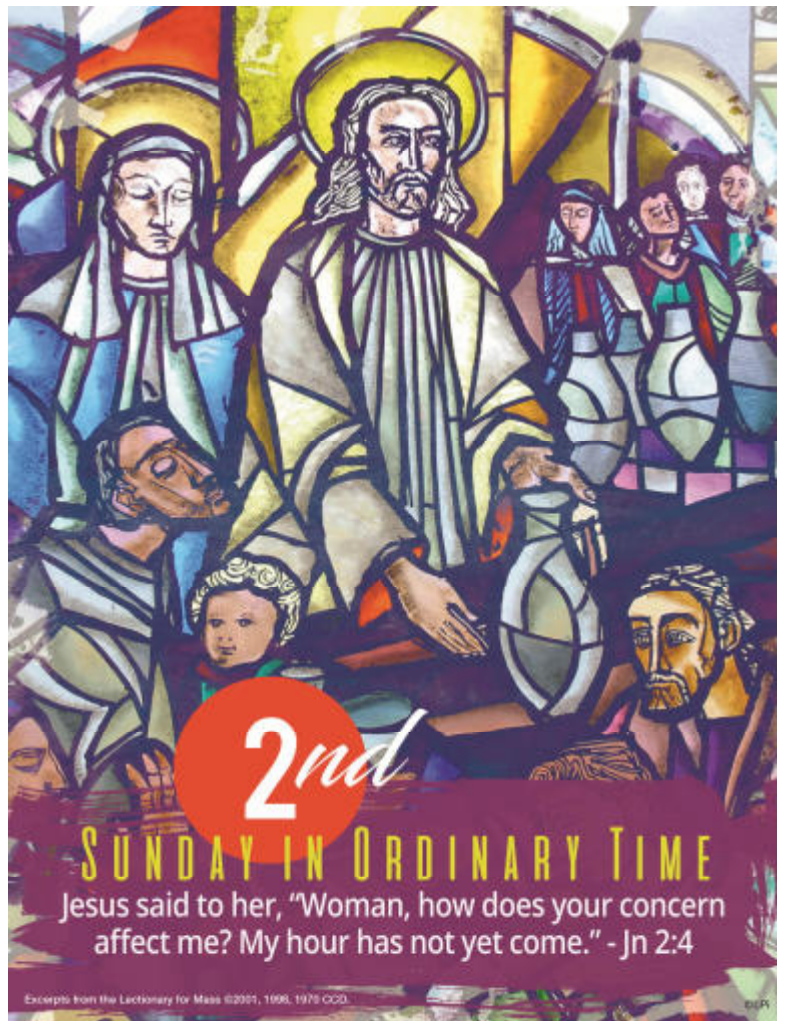

Our Blessed Mother: Right to Life Sunday and the Wedding Feast Cana

"A young man married five years ago, called me on the phone and said, "Father, I want you to come and baptize our miracle." Shortly after they were married they came to see me and they were quite upset because the doctor told her that she could never get pregnant. But they would not believe it. They began praying to Our Blessed Mother that some day they would have a child. Now almost 5 years later that miracle has taken place. How beautifully this ties in with the miracle of Cana.

A young couple with a problem . . . the wine had run out at their wedding feast. And what did they do? They turned to Mary and of course Mary, being the mother of Jesus, knowing how He would react, went to Him. He seemed to be unconcerned. But she knew that deep down in His heart, He would do what she asked of Him. And, within a few moments the water had been changed to wine through the intercession of the Mother of God. Just as it happened at the wedding feast of Cana, so it happens in our lives today.

When we have problems, trials and heartache, turn to Mary, the Mother of God, who in turn will go to her Son. We can be certain that her pleas will not fall on deaf ears. So as we celebrate the right to life let us also remember that the Mother of LIFE itself is here, ready and waiting to help us!

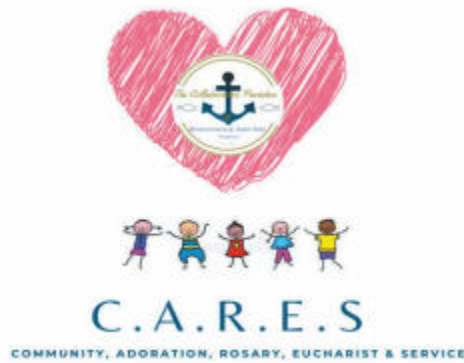
