

### SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Our parish receives a number of requests for Sponsor Certificates from people who have been asked to be a Godparent at a Baptism or a Sponsor at a Confirmation. This certificate verifies that you are an active Catholic, a member of this parish and eligible for this honor.

a) The Godparent/Sponsor is to be at least sixteen years old.b) He/she is to have received the Sacraments of Baptism,

Communion, and Confirmation.

c) If married, the Sponsor/Godparent must have been married according to the laws of the Church.

For the Pastor to issue a Sponsor Certificate:

a) You must be a currently registered member of the parish.

b) You must attend Mass here regularly.

Please call the Rectory (203-924-4929) at least a week before when Sponsor Certificates are needed.
