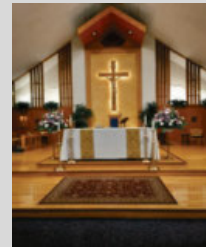

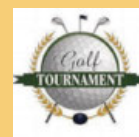

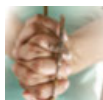
JUNE EMMANUEL HOUSE DINNER

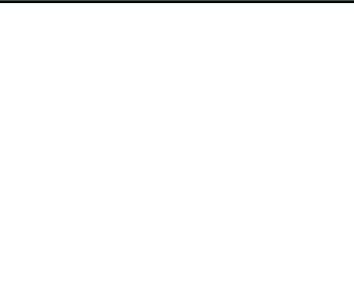

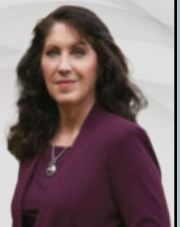
