Back By Popular Demand!

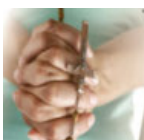
St Gregory will be having a Flea Market

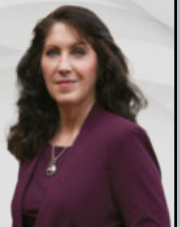
