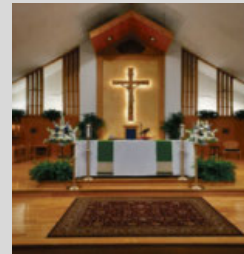

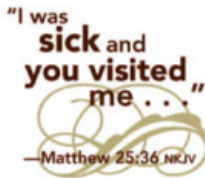
FAITH IN ACTION: JULY EMMANUEL HOUSE DINNER

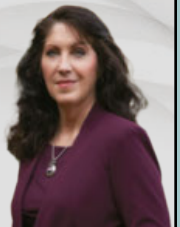
