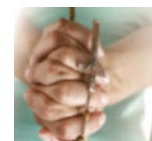
NOTICE! LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS

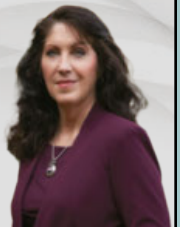
