

Dear Parishioners,

Much is always said about the "Spirit of Christmas," especially in nearly every Christmas movie ever made. In general this refers to a "spirit of giving," as well as hope, and sometimes charity. The quest to find the true spirit of Christmas is always in stark contrast with the consumer culture that has taken over the holiday, turning it into a season of "getting," more than a season of "giving."

St. John of the Cross, whose feast day we celebrated last week, understood the spiritual life in such a profound way that he was able to summarize the true "spirit" of this time of year (as well as the Christian life in general) in the following quotation:

In the twilight of life, God will not judge us on our earthly possessions and human successes, but on how well we have loved.

This insight is most fitting for Advent in the Northern Hemisphere as we experience "twilight" so early. Indeed the shorter days are symbolic of our own final days on this earth, before we enter the "light" of eternal life.

All of this means that during Advent (as well as all year long) we are asked to remember that love and charity is what truly makes us happy and nothing else in this world. St. John of the Cross encouraged an on-going emptying of self of all earthly attachments in order to achieve a greater union with God. In the end, all of this will pass away and all that will remain are the good deeds that we practiced during life and the love we shared. Just some food for thought as we enter this final week of Advent.


