



Dear Parishioners,

Well it's one of my favorites times of the year—time for New Year's Resolutions. Here are ten from Catholic writer Patti Maguire Armstrong that I think are great. I pray you will take to heart one or more of them:

- 1. <u>Give a return on your gifts</u>: When using a gift someone gave you, say a prayer for the giver. For instance, say a Hail Mary for the giver when you wear something someone gifted to you.
- 2. <u>See Jesus more often</u>: Make a weekly appointment to visit Jesus in the tabernacle. Better yet, try to attend one daily Mass a week. You'll never regret it.
- 3. <u>Become invisible</u>: Look for invisible ways to do good. Leave that parking spot near the door for someone else. Put away a shopping cart and pray for the one who left it in the middle of the lot. Pick up garbage you see lying around: *"Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will repay you" (Mt 6:6).*
- 4. <u>Ask God to arrange your seating and conversations</u>: People have amazing experiences when asking God to direct who we sit next to at events or on planes, and to direct our conversations (even when socially distant).
- 5. <u>Pray when you hear sirens or see flashing lights</u>: People in emergency situations always need a prayer. Lights and sirens are "Prayer Signals" for us. Just offer a short prayer for the well being of the people involved.
- 6. <u>Talk to people no one can see</u>: Get to know the saint of the day (any Catholic calendar will let you know whose feast day is celebrated that day). Ask him or her to pray for you that day. If there is no saint that day, ask Our Blessed Mother and St. Joseph to pray for you.
- 7. <u>Give something away you love</u>: It's fine to donate the things you no longer use, but occasionally give away a favorite item. It's the difference between Cain and Abel's offerings to God.
- 8. <u>Have a 'no-complaint' day</u>: Dedicate an entire day each week to not complaining—including weather!
- 9. <u>Fast from something small daily</u>: We're not talking skipping whole meals. Just give up something you like: skip the fries or ketchup, don't butter your bread, give up coffee or don't add cream or sugar, no social media, etc. Something little.
- 10. <u>Give unexpected gifts</u>: While we're all generous during Christmas, there is need throughout the year. Give anonymously to a neighbor who is struggling, bring muffins to your co-workers, send come cookies to your local police or fire fighters or health care workers in nursing homes or hospitals. People love a surprise—it's says they are valued!

I hope those will help to get your New Year off to a great spiritual start! God bless you in the week ahead!
