

Dear Parishioners,

Last January Pope Francis caused quite the uproar in During a reflection on St. Joseph, he encouraged people to be open to adoption and fostering like St. Joseph was for Jesus. Pope Francis said, "This kind of choice is among the highest forms of love, and of fatherhood and motherhood. How many children in the world are waiting for someone to take care of them!"

Then he went on to shock everyone by speaking about a certain selfishness that is causing a demographic winter. He said, "Many couples do not have children because they do not want to, or they have just one because they do not want any more, but they have two dogs, two cats...Yes, dogs and cats take the place of children. This denial of fatherhood and motherhood diminishes us, it takes away our humanity." Ouch! Of course, Pope Francis was speaking to the current "pet parent" phenomenon.

Now I want to be clear (for the pope and myself), there is nothing wrong with having pets. Indeed, pets bring great joy and comfort into our lives. However, you cannot "mother" or "father" a pet (or "grandfather" or "grandmother" either). Yes, we care for pets, but we're their "stewards" or "caretakers". and fathering refers to the raising and caring of human persons. This doesn't have to be biological. It is also through adoption or mentoring as an aunt, uncle, coach, etc. But it is fundamental to the human person according to Pope Francis who said, "Fatherhood and motherhood are the fullness of life of a person...A man or a woman who do not voluntarily develop a sense of fatherhood or motherhood are lacking something fundamental, something important. Think about this, please."

For a society to function and survive, it needs people at every stage of development. The current mindset to limit family size will create an enormous problem in the future as people age and need care. Who will do this work? And who will pay for it? Certainly a couple can choose not to bring new children into the world, but they should be open to adopting or fostering the many children already here and in need.

And how do pets fit into all this? Well pets are a gift of God that brings happiness and beauty into childrearing. They help us stay calm, they lift our spirits, they make us smile when family life is tough. But they can never replace the soul transforming work of raising a family. True motherhood and fatherhood do that.
