

## Dear Parishioners,

After 43 years and over 50 million deaths it appears Roe v. Wade (the landmark 1973 Supreme Court ruling that legalized abortion in all 50 states) is not long for this world. Thank you Jesus—and the millions of people who have prayed for an end to abortion these many years! The current Supreme Court appears ready to strike down the ruling—which would be a great victory. Unfortunately, it seems the Court may return the matter to the states for their own decision. That would be a loss as many states are ready to rule abortion as legal. The simple truth is our Constitution actually requires ending abortion altogether—and the Court should say so. What do I mean?

Roe v. Wade is based on the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the US Constitution which reads that "states shall not deprive any person of life, liberty or property, without due process of law." The Supreme Court, in their decision, defined "person" to mean a mother and no one else. However, just a little historical research shows that the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment was unquestionably written to include unborn children. Since the founding of our country, it was universally understood that unborn children were people and therefore deserve the protection of law. How the Supreme Court didn't see that or take that into account is a mystery—a clear obfuscation by Satan.

Unelected justices have no authority to change the meaning of the Constitution—that is only something the American people can do through our elected representatives. And even that process is difficult— ultimately requiring 75% of state legislatures approving the change.

Given the history and text of the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment, abortion is a violation of an unborn child's constitutional rights and the Roe v. Wade decision is a sham. Returning this matter to the states changes nothing—the constitutional right to life of the unborn person still holds. Our current Supreme Court has an opportunity—and an obligation under the law—to right the wrong of abortion. The Constitution demands it. The unborn deserve it.

Whatever the Court ultimately decides, we Catholics remain unflinching against abortion. It is the killing of an innocent human life, easily verifiable by science. How pro-choice people don't see this is simple—Satan's continued obfuscation. There is no doubt that an unwanted pregnancy is difficult. No one would argue with that. But killing the unborn child does not make anything better, only worse, especially for the mother who is left with the memory of this tragic procedure. We continue to pray for an end to abortion in our country and the world. But in a special way this year we pray that the Supreme Court will have the courage to bring an end to this unconstitutional nightmare.
