

# Father Joe's Notes



My dear friends,

We've finally come to Holy Week, time to remember the work of Christ's salvation. This weekend, we honor Jesus' triumphant entrance into the Jerusalem. Thursday, we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. Friday, we remember Jesus' death on the cross. Saturday, we rejoice at the Easter Vigil, as the Church welcomes the catechumens to the flock of the Lord. Sunday, we glory in the Resurrection of Christ and his conquering death. This week allows us to not only walk with the Lord, but to renew our faith in those most wondrous moments of our salvation.

As we enter Holy Week, we are reminded of all that has changed. It will sound strange to not hear the full choir with trumpet blasts. It will be odd not greeting each other with handshakes or embraces. It will look very different as we enter a church with far fewer people. (Some will say that restrictions have been lifted for capacity, and this is true; nevertheless, we still need to maintain social distancing and



mask wearing. That caps us at about 130 people per celebration.) We will be very aware that some of our community have died during this pandemic, and we will be sad noticing those spots empty in pews. Yes, it is different.

With all that has changed, we still rejoice. Christ loves and saves us! That hasn't changed. Masks cannot prevent us from praising the goodness of our God. Social distancing cannot keep us from joining as a people to give thanks, even while six feet apart. Hand sanitizers do not negate that we have been washed clean in the Blood of the Lamb. Whether in church or celebrating united by social media or television, we as a people stand together to give thanks to God. Nothing can ever change that.

## ✠ Ask Father ✠

**Question:** Father, if I forget to confess something when I go for Reconciliation, is it forgiven or do I need to go back again later?

**Answer:** You should be covered. I say *should* for a reason. If you go and try to think of the big things, only to realize later that you honestly forgot to say one thing, then that's fine. You intended to go to confess your sins and missed something honestly. Your sins are still forgiven; go in peace. If you go and deliberately withhold something, you don't intend to confess it, then that's a different story. You didn't honestly forget; you misled your confessor by refusing to address it. In that case, your sin is not absolved. If you know something is a sin and do not bring that up, with full knowledge that you aren't, you cannot claim you forgot to confess. For those people who get flustered or off track honestly because you are worried and then forget what you were saying, there is no malicious intent to conceal. That's fine. You are forgiven.



## St. Thomas Religious Ed.



### DIRECTOR OF FAITH FORMATION PARISHES OF SOUTHINGTON

The parishes of Southington are seeking a full-time Director of Faith Formation. This position will lead and assist the five parishes in their faith formation program, which will include: Elementary School Children grades K-8, Confirmation Preparation Program, 2-year catechesis program for grades 8 & 9 (with the Sacrament in fall of grade 10), and Adult Faith Formation. The Director of Faith Formation will provide administrative oversight and direction of the religious education programs and parish events for grades K-10.

Qualified candidates must be practicing Catholic with a commitment to the teachings of the Catholic Church and a respect for social, moral and ethical issues; be a Catholic in good standing with knowledge of sacramental preparation, capacity to relate with children, teens and adults; excellent organizational skills, willingness to work collaboratively, and possess good computer skills in Microsoft office and have the ability to update the parish website.

The hours of the position are flexible, as the hours of work will vary from traditional daytime business hours to some evening and weekend hours, which are required.

## Saints Corner

We seek the intercessions of the saints in heaven with Christ. Throughout Lent, we'll review a few saints' names so you know more about the heavenly realms.

**St. John of the Cross:** He was born into poverty in Spain. He joined the Carmelite Brothers at the age of 21, and lived more strictly than the rule of the order required. John worked closely with St. Teresa of Avila, who persuaded him to found the Discalced Carmelites. Together, they worked to reform the order and the Church. At one point, he was arrested and imprisoned by other brothers who objected to his changes. After nine months, he escaped and went back to his reforms. He wrote many spiritual and contemplative works. He is a doctor of the Church. He died in 1591 at the age of 49. He is the patron saint of contemplative life, mystics and Spanish poets. His feast day is December 14<sup>th</sup>.

**St. Paul of the Cross:** He was the son of a merchant from Northern Italy, and grew up as a very pious youth. As a young man, he received a vision and in 1721 founded the Congregation of Discalced Clerks of the Most Holy Cross and Passion (better known to us as the Passionists). At one point, his brothers deserted him, but the order grew again over time. Their mission was to preach Christ Crucified. Paul was a most effective preacher, and often brought even the hardest hearted people to tears. His missions in various countries brought many to a true conversion and dedication to live with Christ. He died in 1775 at the age of 81. He is the patron of preaching and Ovada, Italy. His feast day is October 19<sup>th</sup>.

**St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross:** Born Edith Stein, the youngest child of a large Jewish Family in a region of Germany (now part of Poland). At 13 years old, she lost all interest in her faith. She was a brilliant student earning her doctorate at the age of 25. Edith became a famed professor of philosophy. Over time, she became impressed by the strength of faith her Catholic friends had, so she began to study the teachings of the Catholic Church. She often said that she read herself into the faith. She converted and was baptized in 1922. By 1934, she had entered the Carmelite order, taking the name of Sister Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. She continued to teach and lecture all over Europe. With the rise of the Nazi party, her order removed her from Germany for protection in 1938 and sent her to the Netherlands. When the Nazis invaded, both she and her sister Rose, also a convert, were captured and sent to the concentration camps. They both died in the gas chambers and were incinerated in the ovens along with millions of others. St. Teresa Benedicta was killed in Auschwitz in 1942 at 50 years of age. She is the patron of Europe, martyrs and against the death of parents. Her feast day is August 9<sup>th</sup>.






