Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

We proclaim the Most Holy Trinity as a mystery of our faith. It is central to our Christian faith and life. The doctrine of the Trinity includes the truth that there are three persons in One God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. While we will never fully understand this mystery in our lifetime, the creed we profess at Mass is an invitation to an even deeper understanding of who God is and desires to be for us. The Sign of the Cross and the doxology or "Glory be ..." are two prayers that are easy to say. Use those prayers this week, and as you do so, ask the Holy Spirit to increase your faith in the Trinity.





Religious Education Registration

Registration for 2022-2023 will begin on April 1st and will close on June 30th, for all who wish to participate for the upcoming year.

Our program consists of grades 1st through 10th. All participants must register by June 30th.

Tuition for one child is \$100, for 2 children \$115 and for 3 or more \$125. The First Holy Communion fee is \$30 and the Confirmation fee is \$50. There is space available for anyone needing a payment plan. If a family registers a child/children and then moves out of the parish before the beginning of classes, a full refund will be made.

All families who now participate in the program will be able to print a registration form off the parish website starting April 1st. Families who have not had children in the program may call the Religious Education Office at 781-324-2444 or print and mail a new student registration form. 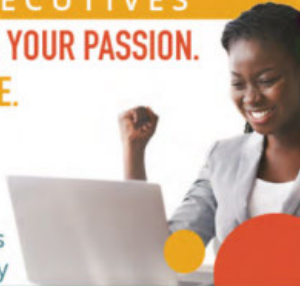
