A Message from *Monsignor Bob*

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR NEWLY CONFIRMED YOUNG CATHOLICS! It was a joy to witness Bishop Caggiano confirm these young men and women with the Oil of Chrism making them adult members of the Catholic community. It has been a challenge preparing these students for this sacrament in the midst of the pandemic. I am most grateful for all the effort and commitment of our staff, our catechists, our parents and our candidates. In addition to their studies, retreats and prayers, they each volunteered several hours to demonstrate their Christian charity and concern for others. This is an exceptional group of young men and women, so please keep them in your prayers. They soon will be entering high school and a whole new world of challenge ahead of them. They need our guidance, support and prayers. Special thanks to Mrs. Mary Craig, our Confirmation Coordinator, for a job well done bringing these newly confirmed to Christ.

We gather to begin the Third Week in Easter Season. We have received many blessings and graces from our observance of Lent and Holy Week. It was a gift to see our church filled to capacity on Easter Sunday, but so many disappeared just a week later. It is a sign that faith is still alive, but we need to encourage those who disappeared of the power of the sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist. We are very much like the accounts in the Acts of the Apostles as we try to rebuild our Church and our parish. There are some who are not heeding the advice of Jesus Himself to not be afraid! Peter denied Jesus when Christ needed him the most. **DO YOU LOVE ME?** is the question with which Jesus challenges Peter. He asks him three times the same question, the same amount of times that Peter denied knowing Him the night of His arrest in the garden. There is much work to be done, much witness to bring to the world, much love that is being lost in a world of secular morality...we are the ones called by Christ to bring to the world a message rooted in truth and filled with hope.
