A Message from *Monsignor Bob*

A MOTHER'S JOURNEY

A young mother set her foot on the path of life. "Is this a long way?" she asked.

And the guide said, "Yes, and the way is hard and you will be old before you reach the end of it, but the end will be better than the beginning."

But the young mother was happy, and she would not believe that anything could be better than these years. So she played with her children, gathered flowers for them along the way and bathed them in the clear streams. The sun shone on them. The young mother cried, "Nothing will ever be lovelier than this."

Then the night came, and the storm, and the path was dark. The children shook with fear and cold. The mother drew them close and covered them with her mantle. The children said, "Mother, we are not afraid for you are near and no harm can come to us."

And the morning came, and there was a hill ahead. The children climbed and grew weary as did the mother. But at all times she said to the children, "A little patience and we will be there." So the children climbed. When they reached the top, they said, "Mother, we would have not done it without you."

And the mother, when she lay down at night, looked up at the stars and said, "This is a better day than the last for my children have learned fortitude in the face of hardship. Yesterday I gave them courage; today I have given them strength."

The children said, "Mother you will always walk with us even when you have gone through the gates. And they stood and watched as she went on alone. The gates were closed after her. And they said, "We cannot see her, but she is with us still. A mother like ours is more than a memory. She is a living presence."

Your mother is always with you. She is the whisper of the leaves as you walk down the street. She is the smell of the bleach in your freshly laundered socks. She is the cool hand on your brow when you are not well. Your mother lives inside your laughter. She is crystallized in every teardrop. She is the place you came from, your first home. She is the map you follow with every step you take. She is your first love and your first heartbreak. Nothing on earth can separate you... not time, not space and not even death.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

If God called men to the priesthood by reaching down and tapping them on the shoulders, we would not be lacking for vocations. But the "call" is much more subtle than that, and responding to it requires a good measure of human encouragement. Vocations are seldom the result of visions, dramatic miracles or near death experiences. Instead, nurtured by others, they grow quietly and gradually, like seedlings which receive the necessary sunlight and water to mature into beautiful and strong trees. It cannot be understated that our homes are the primary places for renewal of vocations. I do not think it is a coincidence that the decline in religious vocations in the United States mirrors the decline in the traditional family structure. Pope Saint John Paul II wrote: "The future of humanity passes by way of the family. So if we wish to transform our culture, and create a culture conducive to priestly vocations, we must first transform our families."
