# - 1 Nessage from Monsignor Bob

"And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim."

We gather this weekend to celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. Another promised fulfilled by Christ who on His Ascension Day told us that we would not be orphaned or left alone to carry out His mission; the Holy Spirit would be given to us. And so it happened. Not only did those driving winds blow open the windows and doors of that locked room but opened the eyes and minds of the disciples to go out to the world and proclaim the good news of the Gospel. They were also given the gifts and graces they needed to accomplish the task Jesus set for them.

Those gifts poured out on them in abundance and gave them the courage to walk out from behind locked doors to the world freed from their fears and anxieties.

Those same gifts are given to us on our Confirmation day. Hopefully, they will free us to not only live our commitment to the Lord but to be witnesses in a world where more and more people are closing their hearts and their lives to Christ.

WISDOM: The ability to discern right from wrong and to seek justice. Wisdom speaks to the ability to use good

judgment and is grounded in life experience, reflection and integrating life's lessons.
UNDERSTANDING: The gift of discernment and insight. It helps us to correctly perceive situations in which we find

COUNSEL: The ability to both give and receive good advice, to guide and be guided by others, to encourage and be

encouraged. KNOWLEDGE: This gift enables us to be able to educate ourselves and build up a base of information from which to live in the world according to the Gospel.

FORTITUDE: This is another word for strength and refers to spiritual rather than physical strength. It is the ability to commit to God despite temptations or external pressures. It is also the ability to endure suffering and hardship in the name of following God's commandments.

PIETY: This is another word for devotion and is the demonstration of commitment to faith. Piety enables us to live a sin-free and moral life, surrendering our will to the will of God.

FEAR OF THE LORD: Fear can be interchanged with the words "awe" or "reverence" which encourages us to give devotion to God and avoid anything that might cause us to separate ourselves from the Lord. Unlock the doors and windows of your heart and let the Spirit in!

Congratulations to all our graduates! This time of the year is a special one as we gather to celebrate the achievements and accomplishments of the students of our parish....from Kindergarten to Middle School to High School to College to University.
