An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic Marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We con only write letters of eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

<u>Sacrament of Baptism</u>: Every 1st Saturday of the month. Please contact the Parish Office for all information.

Sacrament of Marriage: Arrangements must be made with priest one year in advance with one member of couple a registered parishioner for at least six months. A marriage preparation class must be taken.


Journeying Together:


