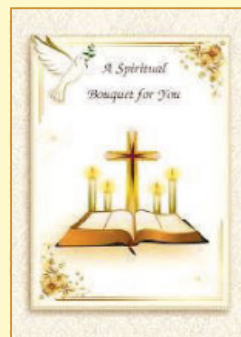


### HOLY TRINITY PRO-LIFE THANK YOU
