



Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?....(Ps.... 22)

We remember the suffering of Christ and are called to accompany others in theirs

How quickly things can change, and how unpredictable people can become! We begin Palm Sunday with the joyous arrival of Jesus in Jerusalem on the back of a colt, with palm branches waving and the crowd chanting: "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord."

Today we are beginning the best week in the whole liturgical year. We Catholics call it 'Holy Week'. We follow Jesus every step of the way. We start with his triumphant entry into Jerusalem, where he is welcomed, applauded, and acclaimed by a big crowd of followers. On Thursday, we will join him at table and receive the gift of Himself in bread and wine. After dining with Him we will walk with Him along the path that leads from the Upper Room to the Garden of Olives. There we will see Him falling to the ground in fear and anxiety about the cruel death that awaits Him. Friday will find us standing beside his mother at the foot of the cross, and feeling compassion for Him in both his physical agony and his mental torment. We will be feeling especially some of his sense of being alone and abandoned, betrayed and deserted, not only by friends and followers, but even by God.

Here the Father allowed the Son to pass through the most excruciating point of the passion; namely death on the cross. At this point, there was a momentary withdrawal of divinity for humanity to pass through the crucible. It was not outright abandonment; it was, rather, a fulfilment of a divine plan, like a mother making her sick child drink a very bitter medication for the child to get well. Though the medication could be bitter, the result is health and wellbeing.

As we step into the Holy Week, we are invited to take some meaningful time to reflect on the events that led to the passion and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. We learn here that Life is generally filled with opposites. At the point of entrance into Jerusalem people shouted: "Hosanna to the Son of David!" However the shout changed into: "Crucify him!" Do not be carried away by praise, always focus on your goal. We learn also that no form of suffering stays forever. We are not stuck in it, we rather pass through.

Let us pray – Almighty, ever living God, you have given the human race Jesus Christ our Savior as a model of humility. He fulfilled your will by becoming human and giving his life on the cross. Help us to bear witness to you by following his example of suffering, and make us worthy to share in his resurrection. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen


