





# POST-SYNODAL APOSTOLIC EXHORTATION AMORIS LÆTITIA OF THE HOLY FATHER FRANCIS ON LOVE IN THE FAMILY

#### Continued from JANUARY 02, 2022...

Thus, building on the gift of Christ in the sacrament, married couples "may be led patiently further on in order to achieve a deeper grasp and a fuller integration of this mystery in their lives".74 Appealing to the Bible's teaching that all was created through Christ and for Christ (cf. Co/1:16), the Synod Fathers noted that "the order of redemption illuminates and fulfils that of creation. Natural marriage, therefore, is fully understood in the light of its fulfilment in the sacrament of Matrimony: only in contemplating Christ does a person come to know the deepest truth about human relationships. 'Only in the mystery of the Incarnate Word does the mystery of man take on light... Christ, the new Adam, by the revelation of the mystery of the Father and his love, fully reveals man to himself and makes his supreme calling clear' (Gaudium et Spes. 22). It is particularly helpful to understand in a Christocentric key...the good of the spouses (bonum conjugum)",75 which includes unity, openness to life, fidelity, indissolubility and, within Christian marriage, mutual support on the path towards complete friendship with the Lord. "Discernment of the presence of 'seeds of the Word' in other cultures (cf. The degree of responsibility is not equal in all cases and factors may exist which limit the ability to make a decision. Therefore, while clearly stating the Church's teaching, pastors are to avoid judgements that do not take into account the complexity of various situations, and they are to be attentive, by necessity, to how people experience and endure distress because of their condition".79 The Transmission of Life and The rearing of children Marriage is firstly an "intimate partnership of life and love" 80 which is a good for the spouses themselves,81 while sexuality is "ordered to the conjugal love of man and woman".82 It follows that "spouses to whom God has not granted children can have a conjugal life full of meaning, in both human and Christian terms".83 None the less, the conjugal union is ordered to procreation "by its very nature".84 The child who is born "does not come from outside as something added on to the mutual love of the spouses, but springs from the very heart of that mutual giving, as its fruit and fulfilment".85 He or she does not appear at the end of a process, but is present from the beginning of love as an essential feature, one that cannot be denied without disfiguring that love itself. From the outset, love refuses every impulse to close in on itself; it is open to a fruitfulness that draws it beyond itself. Hence no genital act of husband and wife can refuse this meaning 86 even when for various reasons it may not always in fact be-get a new life.


