Lent is a time to recommit ourselves to God. We begin by taking an honest look at ourselves. Then we listen to Scripture and pray regularly in the hope of discovering more deeply who God is

and what God requires of us. Finally, we commit ourselves anew to doing what God asks. God welcomes us with open arms. Every Catholic, young or adult, has the obligation according to the church precepts, to fulfill their Easter duties.

Why do we fast, and you do not see it? (Isaiah 58:1-9, Psalm 51:3-6, 18-19, Matthew 9:14-15)

Have you decided what your Lenten fast will be? Isaiah reminds us that genuine fasting involves more that grabbing a fish filet and continuing on our day. Whatever you "give up," be sure that you are making room for prayer each day. Tell the Lord how you hunger and thirst for him. Let your fast become a reflection of the longing. Then, as Lent unfolds, watch to see how God satisfies your longing. Watch, too, for ways that he sends you out to share his blessings with the people around you. Always remember God's promise: "Your light shall break forth like the dawn, and your wound shall quickly be healed". "Lord, I hunger and thirst for you. Fill me/us with your presence so that I can bear fruit for your kingdom."



St. Catherine of Bologna | March 9 St. Catherine of Bologna (September 8, 1413 – March 9, 1463) came from an upper-class family in Ferrara, a in Italy, and received an education at the court, where she learned reading, writing, singing and drawing. But despite her advantages, her heart yearned for God. She joined a group of religious women in Ferrara at the age of 18. Four years later, that same group joined the Poor Clares, an order founded by St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi. In 1456, she and 15 other sisters were sent to establish a Poor Clare monastery in Florence. As abbess, St. Catherine worked to establish the new community. She was a model of piety and reported experiencing miracles and several visions of Christ, and the Virgin Mary. In 1463, St. Catherine of Bologna became seriously ill, and she passed away. She was buried without a coffin and her body was exhumed 18 days later ,many cures attributed to her at her graveside and the sweet scent coming from her body was incorrupt and remains so today.
