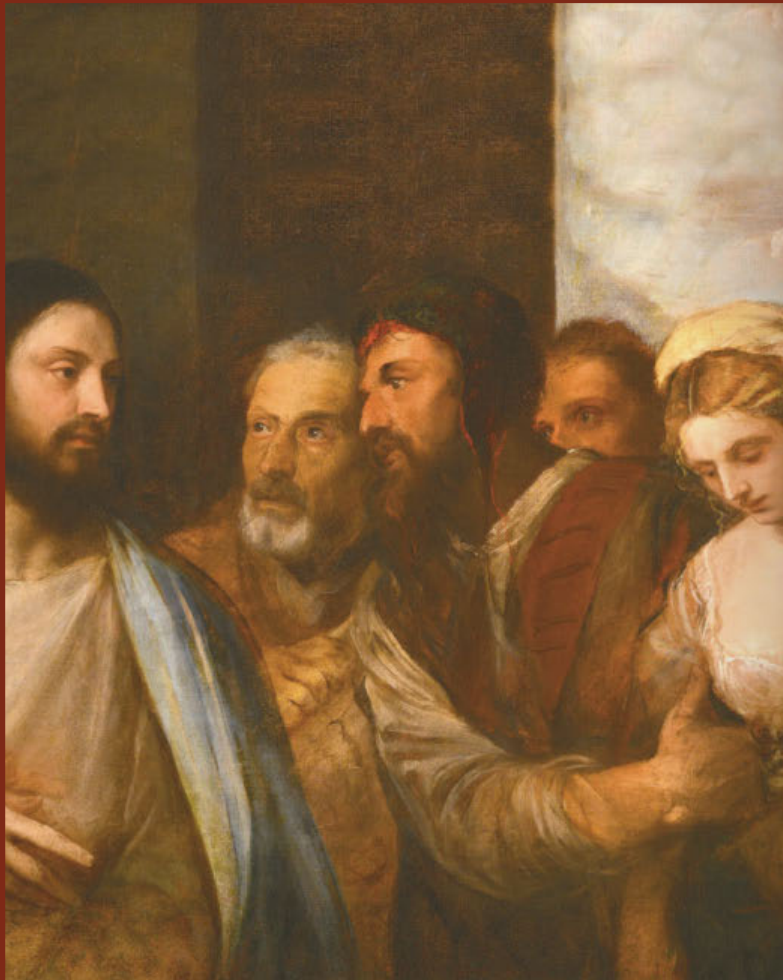

### 2022-2023 FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

Registration for Our Lady of Mercy (Notre Dame and St. Colman) Faith Formation Program for the 2022-2023 school year will take place from **March 1 through April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.**

Parents may register children by going online to the parish website at [www.ourladyofmercyparish.org](http://www.ourladyofmercyparish.org) and printing out this registration form and then returning the form to the Faith Formation office mailbox (black box at the front of the office door)

All children who are not attending catholic school from first grade to ninth grade are encouraged to register. The exception to students at St. John Paul II in grade 3<sup>rd</sup>, and Confirmation Year-1, Year-2 (8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>) will need to register for these sacramental years.

**First time Registration:** Any child/children who are registering for the first time for Religious Education Program **MUST** present at the time of registration their child's Baptismal Certificate if not baptized at Notre Dame or St. Colman Churches.

St. Benedict the African | April 4

St. Benedict the African (1524-1589), was born in San Fratello, Sicily to Cristoforo and Diana Manasseri, Africans who had been taken as slaves. Some accounts claim that because of his parents' loyal service that Benedict was given his freedom at birth, other sources say that his freedom was granted when he turned 18. At 21 Benedict joined a society of hermits living under the rule of St. Francis of Assisi. Eventually he succeeded his friend, Jerome Lanze, as their leader. When the Pope disbanded the independent hermit society, Benedict joined the Order of Friars Minor and he was sent to Palermo, to the Franciscan Friary of St. Mary of Jesus. There Benedict worked in the kitchens and despite being illiterate and a lay brother (not a priest), he also served as Master of Novices, and as Guardian of the Community. St. Benedict was known throughout his life as a brilliant cook under whose hands food seemed to multiply miraculously, a healer, and a spiritual leader with profound understanding. He is recognized as the patron saint of African Americans.
