BAPTISMAL PREPARATION PROGRAMS BEGIN AGAIN IN FALL!

This fall (with the further relaxing of COVID protocols) we plan to resume our parent preparation sessions for infant baptisms in small groups. They take place in the rectory. The one-time program takes place on Sunday afternoons from 1:00 pm to 2:30 pm. The dates for the next three sessions are: **September 12**; **November 14**; and **January 16**. All parents must participate in the prep sessions, led by our prep team, if this is their first child and/or if they do not worship at Mass here on Sundays. Parents whose children are not yet born may participate in the program if they like. *Please call Monsignor Sullivan (508-754-5361) to pre-register for the program*.

We will also resume the practice of celebrating baptisms at our 11:00 am Mass on occasional Sundays (usually monthly except during Lent). We do this because, theologically, the Sacrament of Baptism is a celebration of *the community* and it is important to have a good number of the community present. Having been trained, parents choose which ceremony they would like for the baptism. The next scheduled celebrations of infant Baptism at Mass will take place on **Sundays: October 3**; **November 7**; **December 5**; and **January 9** ~ all at the 11:00 am Mass.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

A Catholic is not fully initiated into the life of the Roman Catholic Church until he or she has received all three of the Sacraments of Initiation. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process of spiritual and educational formation by which adults become full members of the Roman Catholic Church. The RCIA welcomes both people who have never been baptized and people who were baptized in another Christian tradition and now wish to become Roman Catholic. Sometimes people who were baptized in the Roman Catholic Church in infancy but did not grow up in the practice of the faith also participate in the RCIA. If you find yourself in any of the above situations we will welcome you into the RCIA.

For those who participate in and complete the RCIA process in the months ahead, the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist will be offered to them at the Easter Vigil Mass on Saturday, April 16, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. If interested in discussing the RCIA, please contact Msgr. We hope that anyone afflicted by a serious physical or emotional illness, those recovering from or preparing for surgery, or those who experience age-related limitations will receive the sacrament. In the sacrament we always receive the grace of God's healing. The two essential parts of the sacrament are the 'laying on' of hands and the anointing with the *Oil of the Sick*. The celebration of this Sacrament, with the whole community present and praying for one another, is always a powerful and beautiful experience. Next Sunday: A Special Collection for the People of Haiti

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

As you know the epicenter of the recent earthquake in Haiti was in Les Cayes, a diocese with which we have had a long association. Hundreds were killed when the quake struck. Many more are injured, missing and homeless. Cardinal Chibly Langlois was injured when his residence collapsed. One of his priests was killed and it is reported that 18 people were killed during a baptism in the church at Les Anglais. This impoverished nation is still struggling from the deaths of more than 100,000 people in calamitous 2010 earthquake when the latest earthquake struck. For more than twenty-five years the Diocese of Worcester has had a covenant of support with the Diocese of Les Cayes. Eight of our area parishes support twin parishes in Les Cayes. In their tremendous need, our fellow Catholics in Les Cayes need the help of us all at this tragic time.

I am asking all parishes in the Diocese of Worcester to take up a second collection as soon as possible for disaster assistance in the Diocese of Les Cayes. It is my understanding that Christ the King Parish will take up this collection next Sunday, September 4 & 5. We will make a full report on this collection during the Fall. I am very grateful for the generosity of your parish to so many in need in our own diocese and in our covenant Diocese of Les Cayes.
