



## FROM FR. MARK:



The Finance councils and the Parish trustees of St. Mary's and St. Augustin are members of our community who care for the well-being of our parishes in a variety of ways. The members of St. Mary's parish council and Parish trustees and those of St. Augustin are appointed by the Pastor and approved by the Bishop, and serve a six-year term. The councils and trustees meet regularly with me to offer advice on all sorts of matters, but mostly those that pertain to the finances of their respective Parishes (and many matters do). They look at profit and loss statements; examine budgets, policies, investments and collections; and review their parish's fundraising activities and staffing, to name a few. They discuss where we have been, are now, and where we hope to be in the future in regard to our finances, and they evaluate the need to undertake capital improvements. The goal is to ensure that we maintain the financial practices that will best safeguard each parish now and in the future. These practices are supported by the Bishop and clearly outlined in our *Diocesan Control* Manual.

When I was appointed Pastor of St. Mary's and St. Augustin, the trustees and council members offered immediate support, letting me know they were well aware of the many demands placed on me as soon as I arrived. I felt blessed to have their support, recognizing the love they have for their Parishes. In the weeks to come the parish bulletins will permanently post the names of those who serve our community as members of the Finance councils and as Parish trustees. We are fortunate to have such competent. committed and caring individuals volunteer their time and energies on behalf of our Parishes. Fr. Mark
