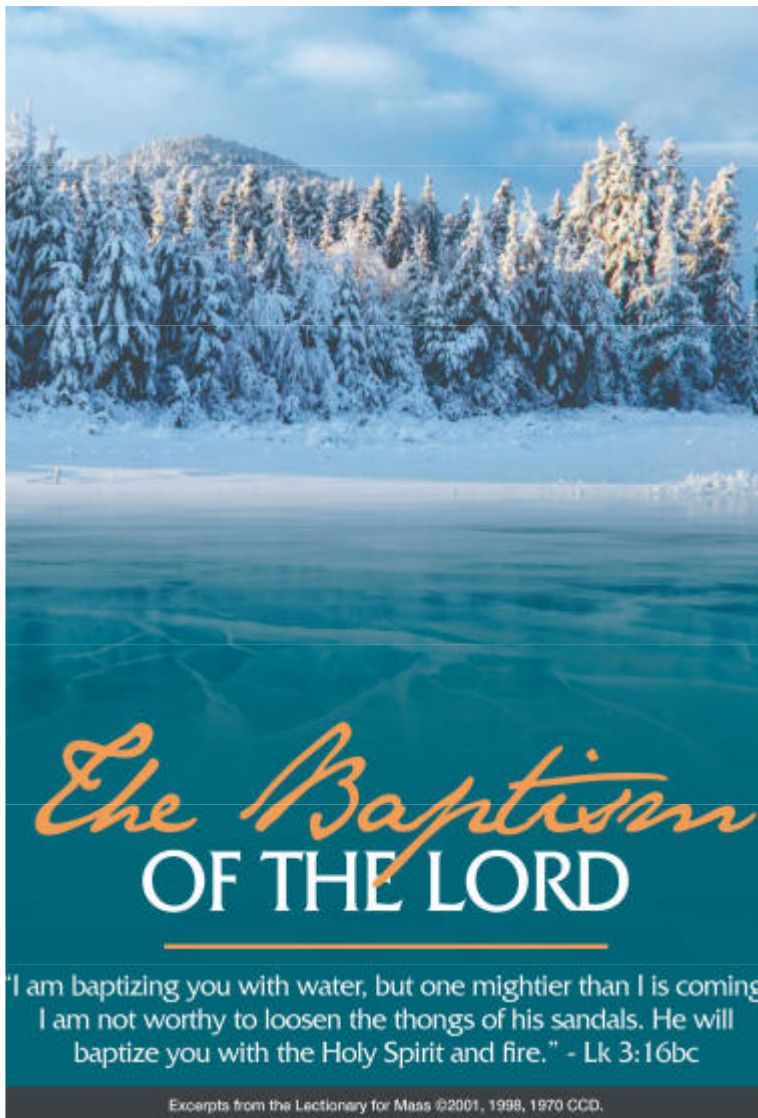

January Collection

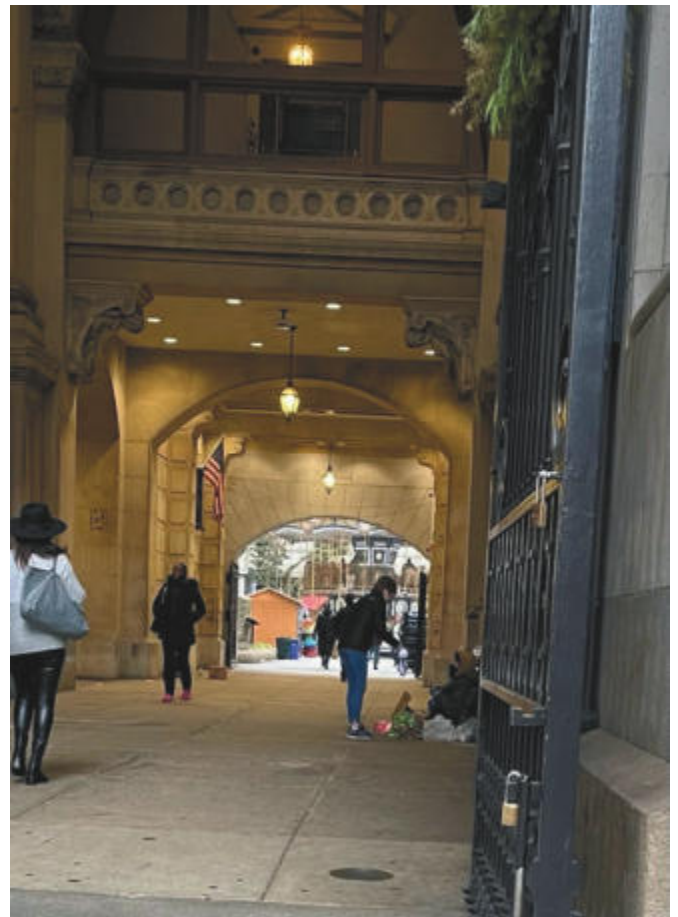

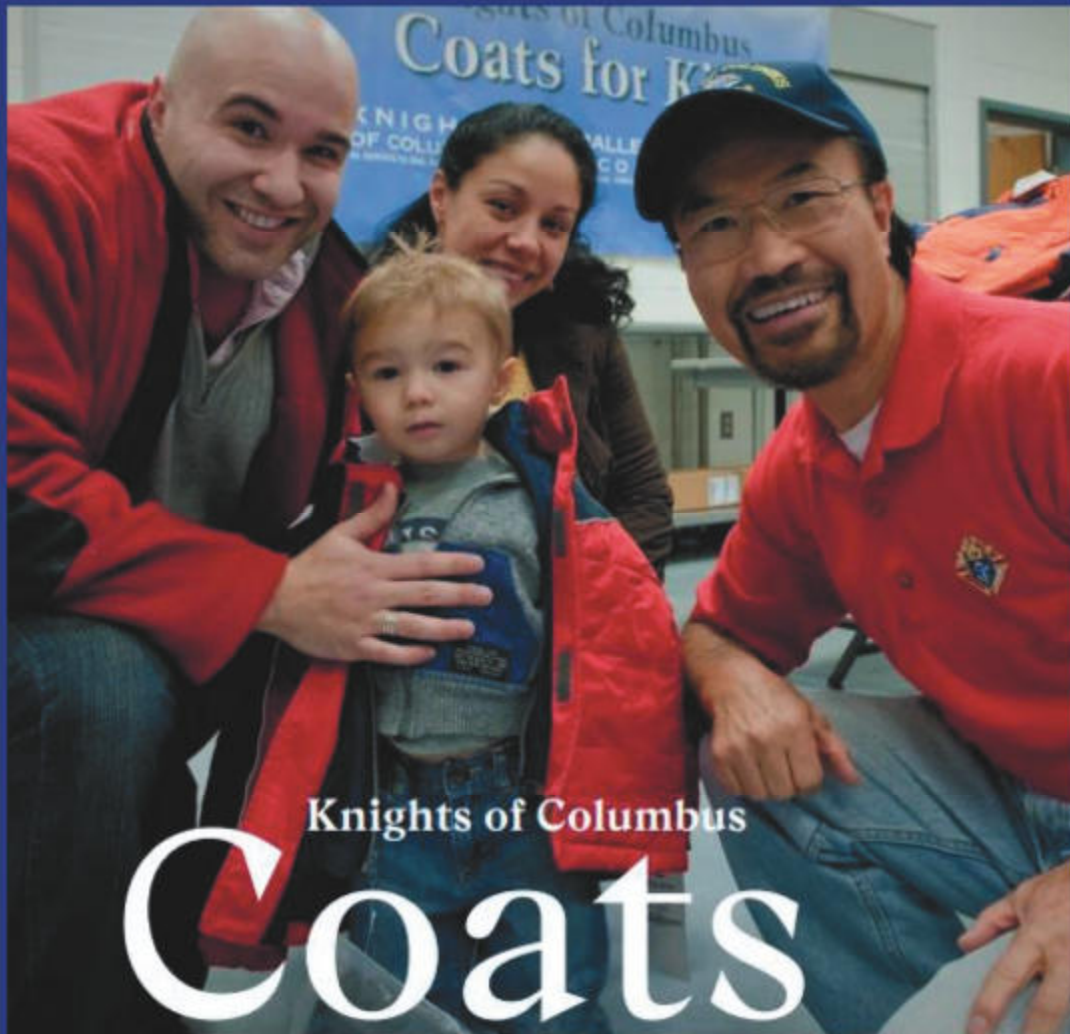
