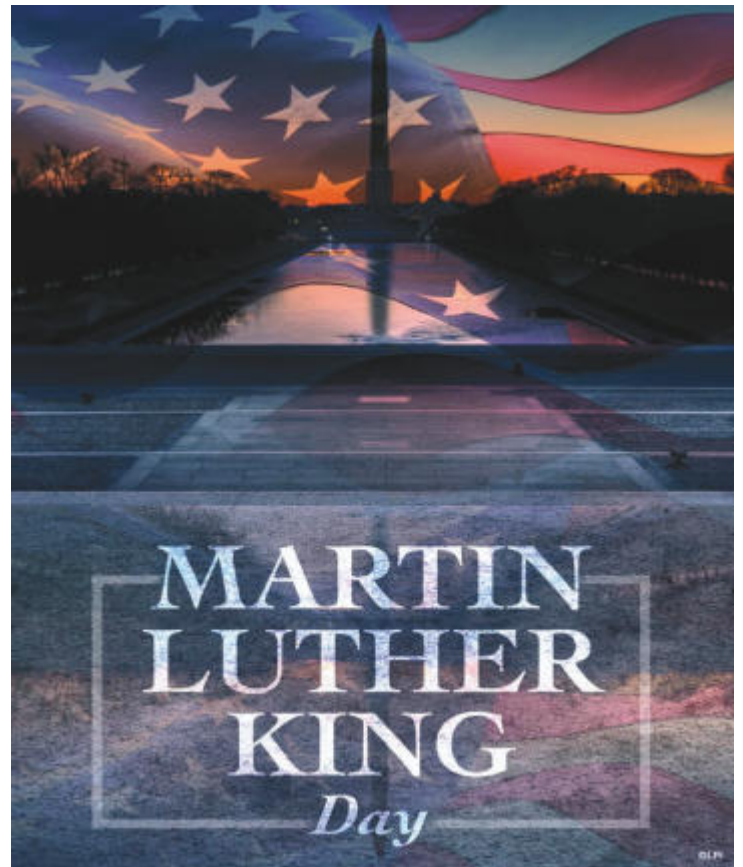

January Collection

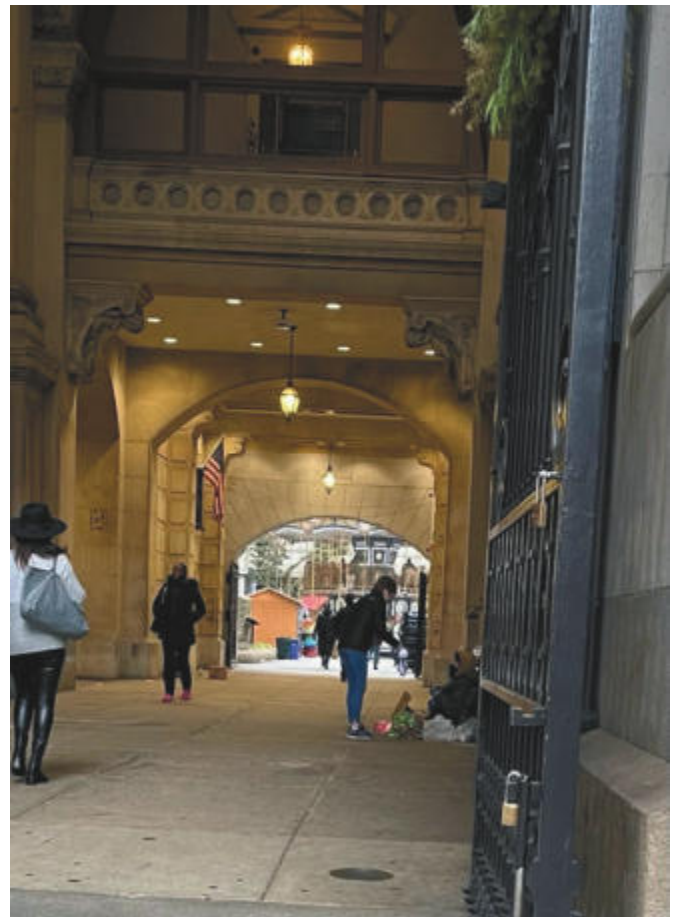
