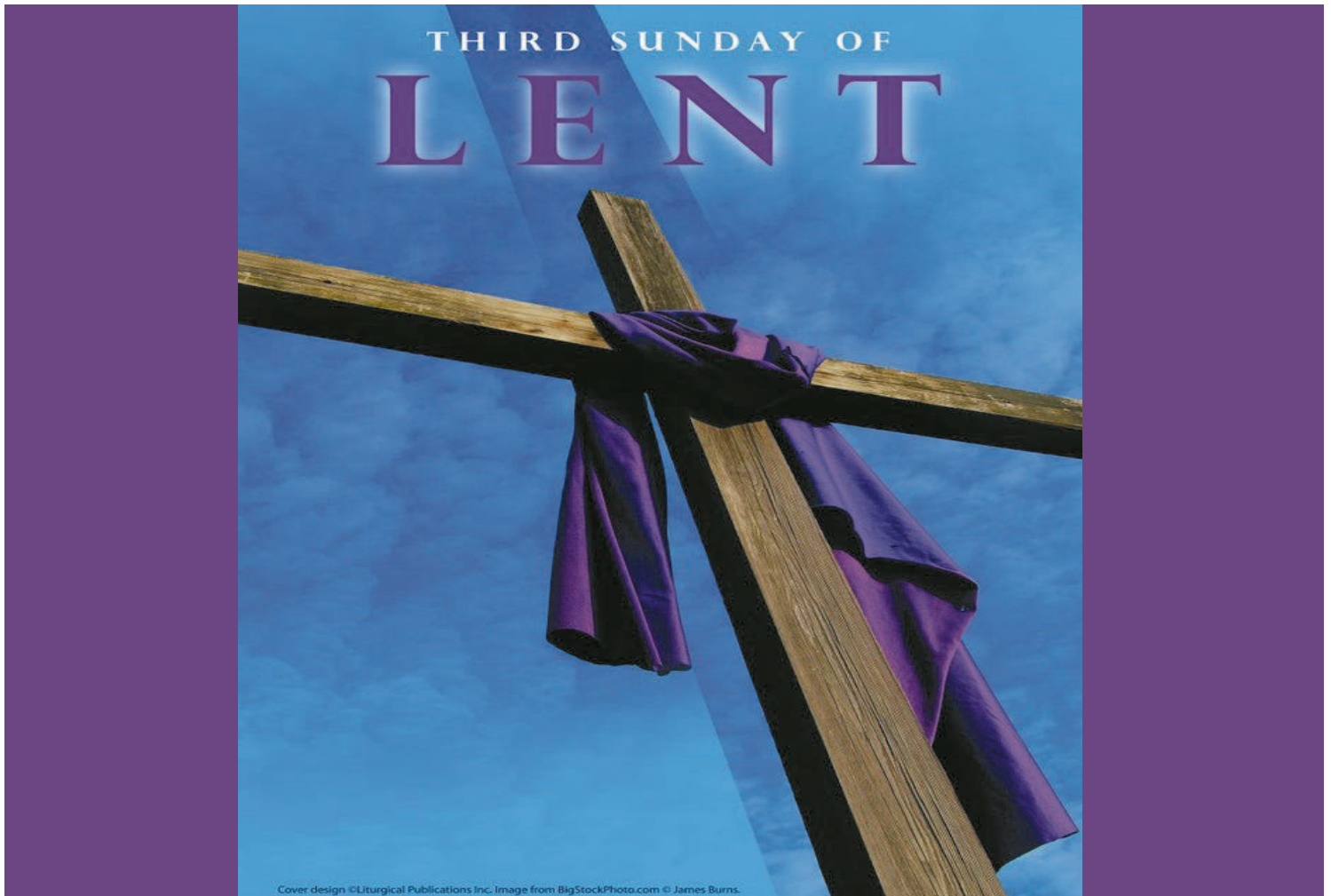

Pastor's Corner

The Gospel of John proclaimed on this Third Sunday of Lent describes a familiar scene from the public ministry of Jesus in which His anger at the desecration of the Temple leads Him to overturn the tables of the money changers and insist that those buying and selling at the entry ways leave immediately and stop turning His Father's House into a marketplace. But it is later on, when the Jews ask Him, "what sign can you give us for doing this?" that Jesus reveals His real purpose. He offers cryptically that if the Jews destroy this temple, in three days He will raise it up. While the Jews are incredulous because they believe Him to be speaking about the stone worship site, He is actually speaking about His Body and His eventual Death and Resurrection. This scene is a precursor of what is to come on Golgotha and at the tomb.

This Season of Lent is a preparation for all of us to experience the sacrificial event of the Cross and the miraculous Resurrection. We are uniting the sacrifice of our prayer for others and our sacrifice for those who have less with the gift of the Cross and we seek holiness because we look to be rewarded for such with a place in what we have come to know as heaven and to be eventually united to Jesus for eternity. We seek a conversion by the grace of God and our own commitments in faith so that we will be dedicated to the cause of holiness. It is why we hear many people offering hope for a "Holy Lent".

One of the ways in which we sacrifice during the Season and always is by giving alms for the satisfaction of basic human needs. We are in the middle of cooperating with the Archdiocese of Boston and all the parishes which happily call this home to raise funds for the Catholic Appeal. The Appeal works to satisfy basic human needs in such areas as housing, health care, Catholic education and other and the Appeal offers a goal for each parish so that working together, as a team, we can do our best for those in need. This year our goal is \$45,200, and, given that we have satisfied our goal for six years in a row, we are confident that, with everyone's help, we will satisfy it again.
