

Pastor's Corner

It has always been a consistency in the lives of Disciples of Christ, from Paul on down, that humble acceptance of sacrifices and even suffering is a way of uniting our lives to the Cross of Christ. Whether it be the experience of the dark night of the soul of Saint John of the Cross or the endured sufferings of many other Saints, undertaking sacrifice has been and is currently understood as a mark of holiness in that such endurance imitates the endurance of Christ in His Passion. So it is that Saint Paul reminds the people of Corinth that he experiences weakness and hardships for the sake of Christ. "Therefore I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and constraints for the sake of Christ; for when I am weak, then I am strong."

Many, both within our parish community and throughout the world experience physical or mental suffering in the form of sicknesses and other burdens which seemingly deny access to both happiness and health. No one should deny either the reality of such or its weight. But believing Christians understand that this life is fleeting and naturally ends in death, no matter how soon or long. We are able to see a spiritual side to such because we point to the sacrifice of the Cross as having the power to relieve the burdens of sin and eventually offer us the possibility of life eternal. When we quote Rabbi Harold Kushner and ask "why do bad things happen to good people?" we do not have necessarily total insight into such but we believe that our spiritual unity with the Cross provides at least part of an answer. Paul's request to have the stings of the flesh that he experienced taken away is answered he says by God who said to him "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness."

It is my wish and prayer that everyone had a very happy and safe Fourth of July celebration and that your summer continues to be enjoyable. Thanks and have a great week!


